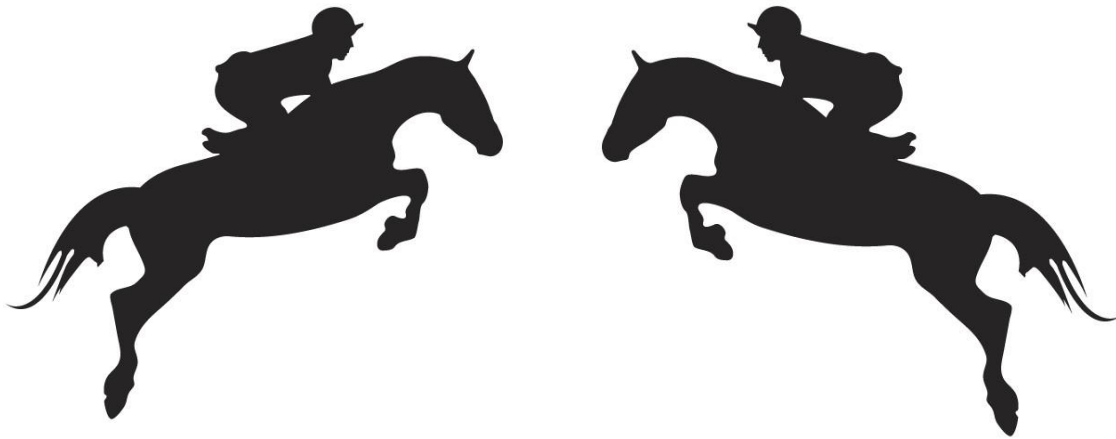

Entry Fees:

\$15.00 per round

or

\$50.00 for 4 rounds

Ground Fee \$10.00 (for Non-BHARC members)

Day Insurance \$10.00 (For Non-BHARC & Non-EA members)

Helper Duty Exemption Fee \$25.00 alternatively, fill out the helper duty form attached to the entry and we will do our best to accommodate you with a helper duty of your choosing.

Conditions of Entry

1. Officials and volunteers; these people are essential in the running of our events, you must treat them all with respect. Verbal or physical abuse and poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated and will result in the termination of your entry as well as further action if necessary.
2. All riders must be gear checked before riding, the gear checker will be found in the warm up arena.
3. The draw will be emailed out to all entrants, please ensure you have supplied a valid email address on your entry form. The draw will also be uploaded to Cavaletti and Facebook event pages.
4. Riding Attire: Any colour riding attire is accepted (Shirt **MUST** cover upper arms, no sleeveless shirts to be worn), approved riding boots and approved helmet are compulsory.
5. Helmets are to be tagged. If your helmet is not tagged you will not be able to ride and compete and your entry fees will not be refunded. As of January 1st 2022, helmet tagging is mandatory for all EA Affiliated Jumping events. Please note: Helmet tagging indicates that your helmet meets current EA standards but does not indicate that the helmet has not been damaged or is unsafe.

6. Riders can only compete each horse at a maximum of 4 consecutive rounds. Multiple rounds may be ridden at the same height or consecutive heights.
7. Riders are allowed to compete more than 1 horse if they wish. Placement in the draw will be considered if they are competing at the same height but will depend on entries.
8. Raffle will be run on the day, tickets available for purchase with entry (see entry fees on entry form) or on the day.
9. Canteen will be available on the day with snacks, lunch options and hot & cold drinks.
10. Yards are available for use on a first in first served basis. Please ensure if you use a yard you leave it clean, otherwise yards will not be available for free in the future. Please clean up your horses hay and manure from the yards and carpark, and place in our manure pile.
