Show Jumping Courses open for walking 9.30 am, starting 10 am Dressage Tests starting 8 am.

Show Jumping and Dressage will be run separately for PCWA and Open. The classes marked with an \* will eligible for PCWA leaderboard points; a \$2.50 levy is applied to each leaderboard class.

You may enter a **maximum** of 3 show jumping rounds across **3 consecutive heights** and a **maximum** of 3 dressage tests at **2 consecutive levels**.

## **TEAMS Combined Training Classes (COMPETITIVE):**

This is an optional team event where one rider will ride the dressage phase, another rider to complete the show jumping phase. Riders competing in individual classes may nominate their individual score to the Combined Training TEAM. – They only ride once but the score contributed to both classes.

# There are only the 4 classes below **\*\*\***They are separated on Global but will only be scored on the below classes.**\*\*\***

- 30cm & SteppStones 3
- 45cm & Prep C (PCWA & Open)
- 65cm & Prelim 1C (PCWA & Open)
- 80cm & Novice 2C (PCWA & Open)
- 95cm & Elementary 3C (PCWA & Open)

## **Combined Training classes information:**

- A Combined Training competition comprises of 'two of the three tests of a horse trial'.
- The dressage and jumping tests, which make up the combined training competition, must be taken in that order (dressage followed by show jumping).
- The scores from both tests will be combined for an overall final penalty score with the lowest penalty score being the winner of the class.
- Combined Training classes will be run based on the 2016 Pony Club Victoria Rules for Combined Training.
- Dressage scores will be scored as per eventing dressage resulting in a final penalty score.
- Dressage will be judged under PCWA eventing dressage rules except -
  - Half or whole marks may be awarded for individual movements and collective marks.
- Show jumping will consist of one (1) round judged under PCWA show jumping rules except
  - The show jumping test is similar to an ordinary Show Jumping Competition, but without any attempt to find a 'winner' of this test on its own. Its main objective is to prove that, the horse and rider are well trained in the specialist discipline of show jumping. It is also to prove that, after a test of endurance, the horses have retained the suppleness, energy and obedience necessary for them to perform.
- Elimination from one phase constitutes elimination from the class.
- One combined training class per horse and rider combination per day.

#### Information & Rules (please read carefully):

- \$10 Ground Fee per horse is required.
- \$30 Helper Bond is required Per horse/rider combination. This will be refunded in CASH on the completion of Helper duty. All bonds must be collected on the day.

#### **Refunds:**

- A refund of entry will be provided less \$10 administration fee with submission of a veterinary or doctor's certificate within 7 days of completion of the event.

#### Membership:

- All riders will be required to present proof of membership/insurance on registration.
- No day insurance is available. EA insurance will not cover you for this event.
- To ride in <u>PCWA classes</u>, riders must be financially ordinary or associate members of an affiliated pony club.
- To ride in <u>Open Classes</u>, riders must be 18yrs+ and hold PCWA open rider membership, mounted coach, mounted adult supporter or affiliate rider membership with a PCWA affiliated club or hold a competition licence with PCWA (No. provided on entry form).

#### Helpers:

- All riders are required to nominate a helper per horse. There is limited self-help available and **only** when organised with event organisers prior to entry. Failure to provide a helper will result in elimination from competition.
  - Riders must not nominate another rider as their helper.

#### Gear Checking/ Presentation:

- Formal PC uniform and presentation is required. Horses must be presented formally as per PCWA gear checking for PCWA dressage and show jumping.
- Open riders must ride in attire as outlined in PCWA Gear Checking manual as per Open Rider requirements. Horses must be presented formally as per PCWA gear checking for PCWA dressage and show jumping.
- PCWA gear checking rules will be enforced.
- Body protectors are recommended to be worn for show jumping classes.
- Plaiting Optional

#### General:

- **No stallions** permitted on Walliston Riding & Pony Club grounds.
- **No dogs** will be allowed on the grounds.
- Limited yards are available to use on a first in best dressed basis.
- A canteen will be available.
- No rider under 18 years of age is to be left on the grounds without a parent/guardian.
- Please leave the grounds as you found them, pick up horse's <u>manure and hay and dispose</u> of it at the <u>manure pit found behind the stables</u>, **NOT** at base of trees THANK YOU!

#### Walliston Riding & Pony club retains the right to:

- Cancel any class or event.
- Change the program at any time or reschedule any event.
- Alter the advertised times.
- Refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
