<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: All riders must have current Pony Club WA membership/insurance. All riders must be able to present confirmation of membership when you pick up your bib numbers on Sunday morning. The Event Secretary and Organising Committee have the right to refuse any entry if you do not comply, with or without stating a reason.

Riders will need to supply their own bib number holders, which must be able to fit an A4 size piece of paper.

REMINDER: Medical armbands are compulsory during this event, please bring your medical armband up to the Office when collecting your bib number. NO numbers will be handed out until armbands have been cited.

The Baldivis course is through sandy scrubby bush and care must be taken by riders to ensure their horse is sufficiently fit and healthy and you ride to the conditions on the day.

COVID 19

If you are unwell, please do not attend and follow the direction from WA Health.

WALKING COURSE

The course will be open for walking on the day of the event, the exact time is at the Hickstead Inspectors discretion, but our aim is from 8am.

PAYMENTS & ENTRY

REFUNDS

Refunds will strictly only be considered upon provision of a medical certificate or vet certificate, where a deduction of a \$20 admin fee applies. If the rider cannot attend due to COVID 19, refunds will only be considered if the rider provides proof of their positive PCR test. Refunds will not be considered for any other reasons.

COMPULSORY HELPERS

Each rider must nominate a helper over the age of 18yrs.

One Horse – One Helper – the same helper cannot be nominated for more than 1 horse or they need to do 2 duties. Limited self-help is available. Please liaise with the event secretary as early as possible to arrange.

If a helper does not report or do their duty the rider is eliminated.

ELIMINATED RIDERS

Riders are eliminated if they have 3 stops at one fence (XC or Showjump) or 4 stops on the course

OTHER INFORMATION:

- Entries close when classes are full or 18th August 2022
- All riders must be able to produce confirmation of 2022 insurance/membership.
- Any one rider can only enter a maximum of 2 horses.
- No rider under 18 years is to be left on the grounds without a parent/guardian.
- JUMP JUDGE BRIEFING: Sunday Morning approx 8am
- All riders must wear a body protector.

- No helmet cameras of any description are permitted.
- There will be no vet on site during this event.
- Qualified First Aid will be on the grounds on Sunday. It is mandatory for all riders who have a fall to report to the ambulance, even if in warm up.
- Canteen will be available on Sunday.
- No Dogs allowed at any time on the grounds.
- Gates open 6.30am

COMPETITORS PLEASE ENSURE YOU ARE READY ON TIME AS EVERY EFFORT WILL BE MADE TO RUN ON TIME.

AWARDS

Horse and rider combinations with the lowest score will be declared the winner. In the event of a tie in a class, the combination closest to optimum time would place higher.

Rugs will be presented to the winner of each class.

Ribbons awarded to 6th place in all classes.

Presentations will be held at the completion of scoring of each height.

OTT SPONSORSHIP

OTT horses must have an OTTWA Passport and provided their ID number with their entry, the horses racing name must be the entered name.

- •Top 10 x Best Performed OTT Horse rosettes;
- Top 10 x Prizes;

Least penalties and closest to optimum time at any height

- •1 x Champion Standardbred rosette + prize
- •1 x Champion Thoroughbred rosette + prizes.

Please note: Riders are to be correctly dressed for presentations.

GEARCHECK

Pony Club WA gear check rules apply, no exceptions.

OBJECTIONS

Protests are to be lodged with the appeals committee in writing, together with \$50, within 30 minutes of the scores being posted. The decision of the Appeals Committee is final and the \$50 will be returned if the protest is upheld.

PARKING

Parking is limited at Baldivis Equestrian & Pony Club. All vehicles must obey the directions of the parking attendants or their connections will be disqualified from competing. STRICTLY NO PORTABLE YARDS ALLOWED AT THE SIDE OF FLOATS.

A limited number of day yards are available on a first come first served basis for fee through entry

HORSES AGE

- A horse may compete in 45, 65, 80, 95 & 105cm competitions from the beginning of calendar year in which it turns the age of 5 years.
- NOTE: The onus is on the OWNER/RIDER to provide proof of Horses Age.

RIDERS AGE

Rider may compete in Pony Club WA Eventing Classes as follows:

- 95cm Classes: From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns 12
- 80cm Classes: From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns 11
- 65cm Classes: From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns 10
- 45cm Classes: From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns 9
