CONDITIONS:

- For the breed classes All Exhibits/ Exhibitors must be current members and up to date registrations for 2022 except for unregistered breed, best presented, handler, show hack and hunter classes. Horses do not have to be registered for ridden classes except for the ASH ridden classes. Pony Club classes must provide a copy of their current pony club membership.
- Horses cannot compete until entry fees are paid in full & disclaimer form signed.
- No refund will be given unless Vet certificate is provided
- All riders must wear current safety approved helmets & smooth soled riding boots when riding at all times
- Ground Fee: \$10.00 per horse/pony (compulsory) for the day.
- Members are those of the Kojonup Equestrian Club
- Entry Fees \$12 per class
- Whole day entry – includes all classes horse or rider is eligible for - \$70 for non-members, \$60 for members – please send through which classes you would like to enter.
Abusive Behaviour or Language will NOT be tolerated, and you will be asked to leave the grounds immediately
- Classes will not be held up for any competitor.
- It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure they are ringside in time to compete in their class
- The Show Society & Kojonup Equestrian Club accepts no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to competitors, gear, mounts, & persons entering the ring do so at their own risk. Lodgement of an entry form is deemed to be acknowledgment by exhibitor of his/her agreement that persons entering the event do so at their own risk
- The Kojonup P. & A. Society (Inc) & Kojonup Equestrian Club hold the right to delete or alter any event without notice
- The Kojonup Equestrian Club Inc reserves the right to cancel, combine or split any classes if warranted. Judges have the authority to divide any classes at their discretion
- Horses / Ponies must be nominated for each class entered with full registered name and current registration number plus copies of breed certificate and current membership cards. All entries in breed classes need to send in their relevant current Breed society membership and horse registrations.
- All Stallions/Colts must wear suitable head gear & be handled / ridden by person 18 years of age or older. Stallions must wear a stallion ID disc on the head-piece (obtainable from EA)
- Any Exhibit deemed dangerous or unruly will be asked to leave the ring immediately
- Ponies and Horses may enter more than one breed class if registered with each respective breed.
- Quarter Horse Please note Aust & American are in same Classes You NOT Eligible for “Any other registered Breed” Exhibits may only be entered in either the Hunter Class or Show Hack – Not Both.
- Entry to this show is done with your knowledge COVID-19 is still active in Australia and Kojonup P & A Society and the Kojonup Equestrian Club will not be held liable for any COVID-19 related incident that may occur as a result of participation. All current government restrictions in place at the time of this event will be adhered too. No refund or credit of entries will be made after the closing date of entries except in the case of an exhibitor being required, by law, to self-isolate or be in quarantine due to COVID-19 risk or exposure. Lead Rein Rider Under 10yrs

A4- Lead Rein Smartest on Parade

A5- Lead Rein Rider - *rider not eligible for any other Pony Hack Events*

A6- Lead Rein Pony Hack

Ridden Pony 14.2hh and under

A7 - Rider 10yrs up to incl 14yrs - Riders to wear jodhpur boots only

A8 - Rider 15yrs to 18yrs
