Entries close at 7pm on Sunday 30th of October or when have reached the maximum amount of rounds we can cater for,

Gates open 7.00am, 7.30 am Course Walk, 8.00 am first round of jumping

General admission to the show opens at 10am

Anyone wishing to enter the show prior to this time must be in the vehicle with the rider

There will be two timeslots for entering and leaving the show, in the morning and before lunch. Times TBC

All riders to provide one helper per horse, limited self-help available by prior arrangement (email serpyshowjumpjobs@gmail.com before close of entries), no self-help if riding 2 or more horses unless by prior arrangement. If you require self- help we would prefer if you choose set-up/ pack away as your helper duty. If a person is named as a helper for more than one rider, more than one job will be given.

Horse /Rider combinations may compete in a **maximum of three consecutive heights this means you cannot skip a height.**

There will be **no non-competitive** rounds available so **you cannot jump the same height twice on the same horse.**

One horse, one rider. Maximum of 3 horses per rider. Maximum of 2 horses per rider in any one height,

All riders must be gear checked before competing. PCWA gear checking rules will apply for all classes and competitors are responsible for being aware of these rules.

Scratching's/Refunds: Competitors must notify the organisers of withdrawal prior to close of entries to obtain a refund minus \$5 bookkeeping fee.

After this date, a refund will only be given if a Vet or Doctor's certificate is received by the organiser within 2 weeks of the event. A \$10 bookkeeping fee will apply.

Organisers reserve the right to amend/ join classes as required and have the absolute discretion to refuse entry to, or eject any competitor from any class, event or series for any reason. Organisers reserve the right to reschedule any event

Organisers reserve the right to determine and amend prizes (including rugs) for each and any class, event or the series according to the level of entries or any other reason. Please note the 30 & 45cm classes are a combine Leading Rein and Ridden class.

Please clean up after yourself and your horse and leave our grounds the way you found them.

SUPER TWO PHASE (Article 274.5.6 – Competition in Two Phases) • Conducted under Table A rules, not against the clock in the first phase, and against the clock in the second phase. Pony Club WA Showjumping Reference Document 2020 14 • It comprises two phases run without interruption, each at an identical or different speed, the finishing line for the first phase being identical with the starting line for the second phase. • The first phase is a course of 5 to 7 obstacles with or without combinations. • The second phase takes place over 4 to 6 obstacles, which may include one combination. • Unless eliminated, athletes penalised in the first phase may continue in the second phase. • The winner is according to the aggregate penalties in both phases (faults on obstacles and penalties for exceeding the time allowed in both phases) and, if necessary, according to the time of the 2nd phase
