Conditions of Entry

Please read conditions carefully prior to sending in your entry. The Organising Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program at their discretion.

ALL HORSES ENTERED IN HALTER AND RIDDEN BREED CLASSES MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE AWWHA

All entrants in breed classes must be current financial members of the AWWHA

1. The AWWHA, shall not be liable for any financial loss or damage, physical injury or property damage suffered by any exhibitor/spectator with respect to any property/exhibit being exhibited by him/her or any other exhibitor, whether caused by or attributed to the negligence of the Associations or any of its servants or agents. The Associations shall not be held responsible for any accident that may be caused by an exhibitor or spectator.
2. All owners of AWWHA horses must be current AWWHA members.
3. For insurance purposes, competitors who are NOT members of EWA or AWWHA who will be showing/riding a horse on the day must complete and return the attached DAY MEMBERSHIP form for the AWWHA. A fee of \$25 per competitor applies.
4. All competitors; handlers and riders, (AWHA members/EWA members or AWWHA day members) must sign a disclaimer. There are two types of disclaimers, one for members and one for non members.
5. **A Signed Disclaimer MUST Accompany the Entry Form.**
6. **Entries MUST** be accompanied by a copy, front and back, of the horse's registration papers. Incorrect or incomplete entries and/or insufficient payment will result in entries being returned for correction and must be returned to the Organising Committee by the close of entries or late penalties will apply. The Organising Committee reserves the right to refuse/cancel or accept conditionally any entry.
7. All registration papers must be available for viewing on the day. Horses date of birth will be calculated as of 1st of August 2022
8. The use of prohibited or performance enhancing substances is not permitted under any circumstances. Horses May Be Swabbed Randomly. Positive results will be subject to penalties as per EWA guidelines.
9. The Judges decision is final and discussion will NOT be entered into.
10. All ridden horses MUST be a minimum of 3yrs of age.
11. Ridden classes will be held in accordance with the current WA dressage rules (as amended) including gear check rules.
12. Stallions MUST be handled by a person 18yrs or over in suitable and substantial headgear including a bit at all times. Stallions halter or ridden, MUST at all times be in the control of persons 18yrs or over.
13. Safety Standard Approved current helmets MUST be worn at all times while mounted. Standard of Dress: Closed in/fully covered shoes MUST be worn in halter classes. Clothing MUST be appropriate for the activity. English Riding attire is also acceptable. Competitors inappropriately dressed may be asked to leave the ring by the Judge or Organising Committee.
14. No refunds will be given unless accompanied with a vet certificate. No entries on the day will be accepted.
15. All competitors, owners, riders, handlers etc are bound by the AWWHA code of conduct. A copy of which can be found on the AWWHA website.
16. If the event must be cancelled for whatever reason, competitors will receive a full refund minus the 5.5% processing fee charged by nominate

Entries via Nominate – **Entries shut Monday 20th of March 2023** – no late entries will be accepted.

Fees: Halter and Ridden \$15 PER CLASS.

Dressage: \$25 a test for AWWHA members. \$30 a test for non AWWHA members

Ground fee: \$10 PER HORSE

Foals will be shown first up so they are able to go home. Please note the arena that the foals will be shown in is fully enclosed. Foals can be shown on their mares if not weaned. Please check the status section of your foals registration papers to see if they are Studbook/Studbook Appendix or WPRB/WID.
