Conditions of Entry

- 1) Entries will close on Friday 10 February 2023 or when classes are full. Entries will be on a first come first served basis.
- 2) The program may be altered at the direction of the organising committee of Riverside Riding Club (RRC)
- 3) By submitting an entry to RRC Open Unofficial Dressage Day, the competitor acknowledges acceptance & understanding of the Conditions of Entry to this event.
- 4) By attending competitors acknowledge acceptance & understanding that they participate in this event at their own risk.
- 5) This event will be run in accordance with the current 2023 EA National Dressage Rules.
- 6) This event is an EWA Interschools qualifier.
- 7) A horse or pony can enter no more than 2 consecutive levels & complete in a maximum of 2 tests per day. Horse/Pony must be at least 4yrs of age to compete.
- 8) One horse, one rider combination.
- 9) Time of classes may change, so it is the competitors responsibility to check the draw. Updates will be available on the day of competition from the clubrooms.
- 10) Final draw will be published on Facebook event page on Wednesday 22 February.
- 11) All horses/ponies are eligible to enter this RRC open unofficial event, however the competitor must be a current financial member of EWA or RRC. Day Club Membership is available at \$10 per competitor and payable at the time of entry.
- 12) There is no maximum age for riding at this RRC event, however the minimum age applies for the start of the year they turn 8yrs of age to ride a pony & on horses from the year in which they turn 10 years of age.
- 13) Entry classifications for this event are – Open 17yrs & over – Young Rider Under 17yrs.
- 14) Stallion disc for stallions must be worn on both sides of the bridle or saddlecloth as well as a headcollar at all times.
- 15) Entry fee per test is \$25 or \$20 for RRC members
- 16) A compulsory \$10 ground fee per horse is payable at the time of entry
- 17) RRC will not charge a helper fee, however the committee would greatly appreciate if a few people could volunteer for a variety of roles throughout the morning. These can be found on the entry form.
- 18) It is the competitors responsibility to ensure saddlery & equipment comply with current EA rules.
Please note jackets & plaiting are optional. Horses must be presented neat & tidy. Matchy Matchy horse/rider outfits welcomed.
- 19) Refunds - Entries will be refunded in full for withdrawals before the advertised closing date of entries. Entries will not be refunded after this advertised closing date. Medical/Vet certificates must be submitted within 24hrs of the event for a full refund.
- 20) Scratchings/Withdrawals – please contact Julie Van De Sande 0408 890 073.
- 21) Caution Cards – RRC appreciate the valuable contribution our volunteers & officials are to the sport. Where competitor, helper or supporter breaches the EA code of conduct, caution cards will be issued.
- 22) Warm up – as per the Dressage WA website, correct protocol in the warm up arena is expected. There is no lunging allowed in the warm up areas on the oval. Lunging areas are in the enclosed paddock to the left of the ground entrance or the sand area.
- 23) All competitors must report to the marshall/gear checker for inspection 20minutes prior to competing. Gear check is required prior to each test. Once gear is checked competitors must not dismount or leave the warm up area. Failure to have a gear check the competitor will be deemed eliminated from the that class.
