The pair entry must specify which phases are to be used for each competitor. Competitors competing as a pair and an individual must do so in the same grade.**

****Each member of a team must complete 1 of the 4 phases, competitors may also compete as individuals and use the scores from 1 phase of their individual entry for their team entry. The team entry must specify which phase is to be used for each competitor. Competitors competing as a team and an individual must do so in the same grade. Competitors may not enter both a pair and a team class. TEAMS USE 2 X pairs entry form.**

****** All adult open riders must have PCWA open insurance/membership OR day insurance.**

EVENT INFORMATION PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

This event will be run under the Pony Club WA Tetrathlon rules and/or Pony Club WA Hickstead rules. The jumping phase will be run as a Hickstead with a combination of show jumps, slip rail, gate and cross-country portable jumps which may include a water jump. The jumping classes 21-24 will be in the enclosed arena and will not include slip rail, gate or water jump. The jumping phase is to be ridden in cross country riding attire (i.e., pony club members must wear their clubs approved cross country uniform) and open riders must wear the equivalent e.g., long sleeved shirt. Approved boots, jodhpurs, helmet and body protectors must be worn. Pony Club gear checking rules will be enforced for all classes. Day Insurance is available to competitors over 18 years of age in the social or team classes. Rider insurance is \$45 and unmounted insurance \$15 for the weekend for running, swimming and shooting phases. Insurance to be paid with entry.
