OVERALL HIGH POINT AWARDS

To gain a Versatility Ranch High Point at this show, the horse, Youth or Amateur must have competed in a minimum of one (1) class in each of the categories offered to be eligible for that High Point award. All youth classes held must count towards the Youth award, same as for Amateur & Select and All Age Horse.

FEES:

- Entry Fees listed next to class name

- Ground fee \$10 per day, per horse
- Yard/Camping if Free – no allocations, plenty of yard available. Pick up your manure and hay or a cleaning fee of \$50 will apply.

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SHOW RULES

- Horses 3 years of age and older only permitted in Versatility Ranch events.
- All youth competing & or taking part must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of the event, whilst the youth attend the event. If the responsible adult in charge needs to leave for any reason, they must appoint another responsible adult to oversee care for that youth and notify the show office prior to leaving.
- This show is run as per the AQHA Rule Book.
- **Equipment:** no hoof polish, no braided or banded manes or tail extensions trimming inside ears is discouraged trimming bridle path is allowed, also trimming of fetlocks or excessive (long) facial hair equipment with silver will not count over a good working outfit. Silver on bridles and saddles is discouraged. It is suggested that competitors use a breast collar and a rear cinch.
- **Attire: Western Attire** - it is mandatory to wear the following in Halter/Showmanship/Conformation and other western classes: long sleeve shirt, collar (band, stand-up, tuxedo, etc.) western hat (the hat must be on the rider's head when the exhibitor enters the arena) western pants/jeans western boots. **Optional Attire** - Spurs, chinks, and chaps in ridden classes. NB: Western Spurs are not to be used forward of the cinch.
- Snaffle Bit - Horses aged over 3yrs can be shown in a legal snaffle bit, two-handed at a Walk/Jog/Lope. Official points earning class for registered QHs only. **Stock/Fender/Half-Breed Saddles ONLY (no western saddles).**

- To be eligible to compete in the Versatility Ranch Conformation class the horse must be shown in at least one class in one of the other categories of their appropriate division on the day of the show.
