**All riders to present to the Event Office alongside the Recreation Pavilion off the oval prior to mounting up. You will not be allowed to compete unless you have been marked off in the office. Riders will be able to collect their Rider Bag full of sponsor goodies when they sign in.**

### **ATTENTION EXHIBITORS**

**Those exhibitors with Stallions/Colts, please note, that this event will be abiding by the Equestrian Australia Stallion Safe Practice Rules and Regulations. Please make sure you are up to date with the requirements of these regulations prior to the Gymkhanarama. Your Stallion/Colt green disc must be worn on the halter/bridle or handler at all times.**

#### **Event Information & Conditions:**

The Wagin Riding & Pony Club committee reserves the right to cancel, alter and delete classes and also to refuse entry to classes.

#### **Rules of Competition:**

The onus is upon the Exhibitor/Owner to abide by all rules set out herein.

In the Halter Breed Section, all exhibits must be registered with their respective breed society with the exception of the "Unregistered Breed Classes". A copy of registration must be included at point of entry, otherwise entry will be deemed invalid.

#### **Off The Track Competition:**

Entry into these classes will require a current OTTWA Passport Number. Please direct inquiries to [offthetrack@rwwa.com.au](mailto:offthetrack@rwwa.com.au) to secure your Passport Number. Horses in the Show Jumping Derby classes that are eligible also need to have a Passport Number to qualify for the OTTWA sponsored prizes.

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#### **Intro to Western Trail Class**

Open to all competitors.

This is a class for those that haven't tried a Western Trails class previously and want to have a crack at it.

Can be ridden in English or Western gear as long as approved.

This is a have a go fun event for all ages.

Many obstacles to take your horse around ie gate, tarp, bridge, trot poles etc.

The pattern for this class will be available a week before the show.

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**Stallions and Colts** to be handled and ridden by person 18 years and over and be shown in suitable headgear and display their green disc at all times.

**Dress Code for Unofficial Ridden:** Unofficial ridden exhibits can be shown in English or Stock saddles and Western Exhibits to be turned out accordingly. Double bridles acceptable. All riders must wear approved safety helmets and smooth soled riding boots at all times while mounted.

**All exhibits in the Show Jumping Derby, Mini Show Jumping Derby and Unofficial Ridden on the Saturday and Sunday** are to be plaited with the exception of Western Ridden.

Dressage riders and mounts can be turned out in English or Pony Club gear. **No plaiting required.**

Unofficial Show Jumping riders and mounts can be turned out in English or Pony Club gear. **No plaiting required.**

## **Dress Code for Show Jumping Derby classes:**

Hacking jackets, jodhpurs and regulation helmets and boots as well as Pony Club competition uniforms accepted. **Plaiting is compulsory as this event will be Live Streamed to the world.**

## **GENERAL:**

**Yards: A limited number of yards situated in the Pony Club grounds are available and can be booked through Nominate.**

Yards and grounds must be left litter free of manure, hay and rubbish. Dump containers for manure and rubbish bins for general waste located on the grounds.

Trotting stalls alongside the oval will be available for participants for use during the day on a first in basis. All manure and rubbish to be removed before departure.

#### **Table A Optimum Time**

- SJ01 Encouragement to 30cm Optimum Time, one round only
- SJ02 45cm Optimum Time, one round only
- SJ03. 60cm Optimum Time, one round only
- SJ04 75cm Optimum Time, one round only
- SJ05 90cm Optimum Time, one round only



#### **Afternoon Mini Derby 30cm, 45cm and 65cm**

- MD01 65cm Derby Regs - 2 rounds
- MD02 45cm Derby Regs - 1 round
- MD03 30cm Derby Regs - 1 round

Classes capped at 20 entries per class. Competitors only allowed to ride one height in the Mini Derby.

The Mini Derby will be run under EA Article 277 with the following modifications:

The course length will be between 450m - 700m.

Each horse and rider combination in the 65cm Mini Derby will be allowed to ride 2 rounds, the best result from the 2 rounds will be their acknowledged score.

It will be judged under Table A Article 238.2.2 with a Jump-Off for equality of penalties for first place. Other athletes will be placed according to penalties and closest to optimum time in the acknowledged round.

There will be a JOKER fence available after the course for those that wish to recover 4 faults. There will be an allotted time in which the JOKER can be attempted to be jumped. There will be only one attempt at the JOKER fence. Clearing the JOKER will remove 4 faults from the rider's score. Knocking down the JOKER will incur a further 4 faults. The JOKER is not in play during the Jump Off.

### **Show Jumping Derby Sunday - Sponsored by Oakford Stockfeeds**

SJD01 80cm - Entry \$75 per horse/rider combination plus one-off Helper Fee of \$20 per exhibitor per day

SJD02 95cm - Entry \$100 per horse/rider combination plus one-off Helper Fee of \$20 per exhibitor per day

SSD03 105cm - Entry \$125 per horse/rider combination plus one-off Helper Fee of \$20 per exhibitor per day - **This event is an "Equestrian in the Park" qualifier. A completed round with 16 or less jumping penalties in the 105cm class will count as one of your qualifying events for the horse and rider wishing to compete at the 2023 Equestrian in the Park Diamond Class.**

**Your first round of the 105cm Derby will be counted as your result for qualifying for Equestrian in the Park Diamond Class.**

**Competitors riding the 105cm Derby will still need to complete the second round to be competitive for the prizes on offer for this class.**

**Prize Money:**

80cm 1st Place \$700; 2nd \$200; 3rd \$100; 4th \$40; 5th \$15

95cm 1st Place \$1000; 2nd \$400; 3rd \$150; 4th \$50; 5th \$25

105cm 1st Place \$1300; 2nd \$600; 3rd \$250; 4th \$100; 5th \$40

**Off The TrackWA will award horses with the highest placing in each class with \$50 prize money. Only horses that hold a current OTT Passport are eligible.**

Riders are allowed to enter two (2) horses on the day, however, they will be limited to only the one height per horse/rider combination and the nominated 2 rounds at that height per entry. No horse will be allowed to jump more than 2 rounds.

Entries for the Show Jumping Derby will be capped at 60 horse/rider combinations with approximately 20 entries per height over the two days.

The Derby will be run under EA Article 277 with the following modifications:

The course length will be between 700 - 1000 metres.

Each horse and rider combination will be allowed to ride 2 rounds, the best result from the 2 rounds will be their acknowledgement score.

It will be judged under Table A Article 238.2.2 with a Jump-off for equality of penalties for first place. Other athletes will be placed according to penalties and closest to Optimum time in the acknowledged round.

There will be a JOKER fence available after the course for those that wish to recover 4 faults. There will be an allotted time in which the JOKER can be attempted to be jumped. There will be only one attempt at the JOKER fence. Clearing the JOKER will remove 4 faults from the rider's score. Knocking down the JOKER will incur a further 4 faults. The JOKER is not in play during the jump-off.
