Class Fees:

CCHSAWA members:

\$10 a class per horse/entry

Second horse with same owner \$8

Weekend package \$85 (per horse no matter how many classes you enter)

Non CCHSAWA members:

\$12 a class per horse/entry

Second horse non member \$10 a class

Weekend package \$105 (per horse no matter how many classes you enter)

ONE ENTRY PER HORSE. If you have 2 horses, then you will need to complete 2 entries. OR

If you have more than ONE person using the same horse, you MUST do separate entries.

Late fee of \$30 if entry is received after the closing date.

Day Yards

- These **MUST** be pre-booked with your entries on the entry form.
- **ALL** Hay and Manure **MUST** be picked up before you leave from the yards and grounds. **Otherwise a cleaning fee will be charged.**
- At the end of your competitions **before you leave**, you will need to see a **CCHSAWA Committee member at the merchandise tent** to be signed off once your day yard is checked for cleanliness.
- If horses dig holes in yards or when tied to float/truck the holes must be filled and evened out.

Halter Information

Stallions and Colts must have suitable and substantial headgear with bit, as per breed standard. The age of the handler must be 18 years of age or over. All horses that enter the led classes must be registered with the relevant breed society. Please provide a copy of the **registration papers** with your entry.

Any person under the age of 12 **MUST** wear an approved safety helmet to show a horse.

Ridden

All riders **MUST** wear approved safety helmets.

Jumping

Jumping is open to all competitors

Maximum jump size will be 60cm

Dress Code

All competitors' attire should be neat, suitable for the type of class in which the combination is competing. Competitors should have neat and tidy hair, or alternatively can wear a hat/cap. **NO STUD SHIRTS** are to be worn in the show ring under any circumstances.

Harness Information (All of Sunday's harness classes are for competitors 18 years old and over.)

Please bring with you your chains or leather traces of minimum length 2340mm (2.34 m). Also check that your hooks can fit over 10 mm steel. No carabineers or closable clips allowed, you **MUST** use hooks. **ALL** horses must be bitted.

Novice refers to handler who has not won a class at a harness show.

Open refers to a handler that has won a novice, intermediate or open class.

Maiden refers to horse that has never won a class at a harness show.

The Harness classes are open to registered & unregistered heavy horses.

Any person under the age of 12 **MUST** wear an approved safety helmet to show a horse. (For the junior classes on Saturday)

Points will only be collated from selected classes. If people compete in Beginner, Novice and Open then the highest winning points will be taken from only 1 class.

Protests

Formal written & signed Protests to be submitted within 30 minutes from the conclusion of the event, with a \$50.00 fee (non-refundable). Ground Jury decision will be final and cannot be protested.

The Judge's decision is **FINAL**.

Junior Competitors

Any parent wishing to enter their child in junior classes need to complete the attached *Application for Junior Competitor Levey Entitlement form*. Once completed it needs to be emailed and paid to fedsec@clydesdalehorse.com.au 2 weeks before the show. If not then juniors need to pay the full \$20 day insurance fee. This allows juniors to be covered by insurance for a yearly membership of \$11. **This MUST be done before September 20, 2023. Otherwise, \$20 casual fee will apply.**

Ground and Yard fees and Camping Information

Ground fees are charged at **\$10 per horse per day** OR **\$20 per horse for two days**.

For those camping Friday and Saturday Night, dinner is available at **\$10 per person per night**. Please indicate on entry for if **staying for dinner**. This will cover meals and **one** soft drink per person. Please also state any dietary requirements on the entry form

Please clean out your day yards and areas before you leave.

All classes below are for competitors 18 years and over.

1. <u>WHEELED VEHICLE CLASSES</u> 1. Wheeled vehicle Turnout – Heavy Horse (2 & 4 wheeled, judged separately) 2. Wheeled vehicle Obstacle – Heavy Horse (2 & 4 wheeled, judged separately) 3. Free Workout Class (2 & 4 wheeled judged separately) SUPREME WHEELED VEHICLE (classes 1, 2 & 3) (note Supreme will be judged together)	6. <u>YOUNG HORSE OBSTACLE</u> Horse is to be led on the ground. This will be a timed event. Points will be deducted for any obstacle not achieved. 3 attempts at each item only. Horse under 3 years
2. <u>BEGINNER DRIVER</u> Driver never won a novice event at a working show; horse must be driven in long reins	7. <u>DRIVEN OBSTACLE</u> Must be driven in long lines, timed event. The obstacle course will be set up on the day. Judged on each obstacle and is a timed event.
3. <u>MAIDEN HORSE</u> Horse has never won a first place at a working show. Horse must be driven in long reins	8. <u>LOG SNIG/TYRE PULL – PULLING ARENA</u> Horse must be driven in long lines. Drivers are not allowed to adjust, alter, assist the horse by moving harness or chains, once the course is started until horse and driver have finished the course. Competitors can select which apparatus they wish to use when registering.
4. <u>OPEN DRIVER</u> Horse must be driven in long reins. Cannot compete in beginner	9. <u>SLED DRIVEN– PULLING ARENA</u> Collect the tennis balls going up and bend back through the cones coming back. Penalties apply for dropped balls and knocked cones
5. <u>OPEN HORSE</u> Horse must be driven in long reins. Cannot compete in maiden as well	

NOTE: Classes 8 and 9 will take place in the Pulling Arena at the Top Entrance of the Park

Beginner Driver – no need to wait for placings

Maiden Horse – no need to wait for placings

- Beginner horse and maiden horse all come back in ring for both class placings
- Classes to be judged on a point score sheet set up

Open Driver – pattern 1 driven like a dressage test – no need to wait for placings

Open Horse - pattern 2 – no need to wait for placings

- All open driver and horse come back in ring for placings
- Classes to be judged on a point score sheet set up

Driven obstacle – held where the obstacle course is pre-set up (judge on grass gets a break - obstacle judge is different judge)

Wheeled Vehicle – Free workout class – This class is for those wanting to demonstrate anything they wish to the judges in order to show off their driving and horse's skills in a wheeled vehicle.

Below are instructions and rules for the Sunday harness classes and Junior Obstacle on the Saturday.

Long rein skills

The horse starts with **60 points** and get points deducted for non-completion.

Point deduction whether half or full is the judge's choice

Total points are what the competitor begins with; points are deducted and added at the judge's discretion. There are items, which are clear deduction.

Beginner driver (Judged on Driver) and Beginner Horse (Judged on Horse): must demonstrate minimum of -

Weave cones (10 points)

Halt & back up 4 strides (10 points)

Pick up a ball off cone (10 points for rein control, 10 points for ball on both ends of cone)

TOTAL POINTS: 60 points max per horse – highest points wins

Open Driver (Judged on Driver) and Open Horse (Judged on Horse): must demonstrate minimum of -

Fan left and right (10 points for left fan, 10 points for right fan)

Key hole (10 points for foot staying in the middle of the centre point, 10 points for staying in the key hole)

Back into shafts (20 points) – e.g Knock 1 shaft minus 10 points, know both shafts minus 20 points

TOTAL POINTS: 60 points max per horse – highest points wins

Obstacle Course:

3 refusals at one obstacle is eliminated.

Each obstacle is worth 30 points.

1 refusal = loss of 10 points

2 refusals = 20 points per item

- Water
- Tarp
- Streamer arch
- Bridge

Total start points - 120 points – highest points wins

Kids Obstacle (Saturday Ring 1):

3 refusals at one obstacle is eliminated

Each obstacle is worth 30 points

1 refusal, loss of 10 points

2 refusals 20 points per item

- Cones weaving
- Streamer arch
- Back up

Total points – 90 points – highest points wins

Log Snig/Tyre Pull:

Cone weaving with rope on outside

10 points for exiting each side of the rope, 10 points per cone knocked

Points can be added for things such as technique or other items at the judge's choice

4 cones = 3 weaves timed

Total points to begin with is 40 points. Most points and fastest time wins.

Sled:

Cone weave up and back.

3 weaves through 4 cones up and back (no rope on outside) and timed

10 points for knocking cones

Points can be added for things such as technique or other items at judges

Total points to begin with is 40 points. Most points and fastest time wins.

Cart class:

Overall appearance/correct set up:

Judges choice 20 points

Rein control 10 points

Cart movement control on track 20 points

If you need help from a helper: a hand on a horse loses 10 points

Points can be added for things such as technique or other items at judges

Total points 50 points to start with. Judge to decide the workout. Highest points wins.
