CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

It is a condition of entry that all competitors, whether actually engaged in any event or not, do so at their own risk and will indemnify and save harmless the organizing club, committee members and members from all claims, actions, suits or demands arising out of injury, personal or otherwise caused out of their presence at this show. **Disclaimer Statement forms to be completed and sent back with prepaid entries.**

The organizers of the show have the right to refuse entry to any person, or to demand the immediate departure of anyone considered to be behaving in an unsuitable manner. Competitors are not permitted to enter the ring once judging has commenced.

IT IS UP TO EACH EXHIBITOR TO ONLY TAKE HORSES THAT ARE IN GOOD HEALTH

THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ALTER THE PROGRAM WITHOUT PRIOR NOTICE.

Led Presentation: all horses must be presented in a show bridle with reins or lead. Halters are not permitted for led classes. Colts/Stallions, Juniors and Race Conditioned horses may be left with a flowing mane and tail. Mares and geldings must have plaited/hog manes with tails plaited, shaved or pulled. Stallions must be bitted and handler carry a whip at all times. **No junior is permitted to ride, handle or be responsible for the care of an entire horse.** Whips are not to be used in handler classes and must not exceed 110cm

Handler Presentation: Handlers must be dressed in suitable attire to run and handle a horse. No see through or revealing clothing to be worn. Preferably suits, pants or skirt, shirt/blouse, a suitable dress or ridden attire with a hat and gloves. Fully covered shoes must be worn, jeans and joggers are not permitted.

Ridden Presentation of Horse & Rider: Horse presentation is that of Led horses with the exception that all horses must be plaited. Jacket, stock/tie, vest, breeches, boots, gloves should be clean and color coordinated to match horse. Helmets must be approved and not expired. Junior riders are not permitted to use long boots in their rider classes. Top Hats are approved for senior riders competing in the Intermediate & Open classes only at this event. If at any stage the Top Hat becomes dislodged the rider must stop immediately, dismount and secure it before mounting again. The judge will deem whether you are to recommence your workout or start again.

Number holders are optional but preferred.

Elementary (Walk/Trot) Ridden Horses:

All Standardbreds are graded as Elementary until such time they have competed at SPPHAWA events for longer than 12 months and won 3 Champions. IF you have competed in ANY CANTER class at **any event** you are no longer eligible to compete. This includes eventing & dressage.

Intermediate Ridden Horses:

For horses that are further advanced than Elementary Walk/Trot but not quite ready for Open Hack. These horses should show a degree of softness throughout the gaits and be capable of executing canter on either rein. Only SPPHAWA Intermediate classed horses or non-members confident their horse can demonstrate the requirements of this class and grade will be accepted. **Double bridles are not permitted in this grade with a snaffle taking preference.** Walk/Trot graded horses will not be eligible to drop back to that grade if they choose to compete in these classes. A judge has the right to ask an exhibit to leave the ring if deemed to be working in an unacceptable manner.

Open Ridden Horses:

Only for horses that are either assessed with SPPHAWA as Open or others who are not members and deem that their horse has an acceptable level of training to walk, trot and canter in a rounded frame on a circle and also in an individual workout. Your horse must also demonstrate clean transitions in all of its work and obedience to the rider. Once the horse has competed at this level you may not drop back to the Intermediate grade.

Notes for entering Classes:

Best Presented Classes – all winners of Best Presented classes are eligible to contest the Champion Best Presented Exhibit at the end of led judging. Any second-place getter is eligible to contest for Reserve if the winner of your class wins Champion.

Led Classes – you can only compete in one section. **Junior, Race Conditioned, Sporthorse or Senior Genders**

Sporthorse Class – this class is specifically for horses that compete in 'other' disciplines e.g Jumping, Eventing, Endurance. Proof of performance in the past 6 weeks must be provided (results listing from such event) with entry forms. You can only compete in this led class and not any others (mare, gelding etc)

Race Conditioned – this section is for horses that have raced within the last 6 weeks. You must state the date the horse raced and this will be checked for verification. **You cannot enter any other Led Section – Junior, Stallion, Mare or Gelding**

Show Hack/Show Hunter classes – you can only compete in one section in the led and ridden, not both. Please select the class that best suits your horse.

A NO REFUND WILL POLICY WILL APPLY UNLESS THIS EVENT IS CANCELLED

ALL ENTRIES MUST PROVIDE AN OTT PASSPORT

SWABBING MAY TAKE PLACE – PLEASE ENSURE YOU HAVE YOUR REGISTRATION CARD (IF SPPHAWA REGISTERED) OR A PRINTOUT OF YOUR HORSES DETAILS FROM THE HRA SITE. NO CHAMPION EXHIBIT CAN LEAVE UNTIL THE SWAB DRAW HAS BEEN COMPLETED

Description of Activities¹: Any equestrian event that is run by SPPHAWA

Risk Warning

I am aware that by my participation in any activities arranged by the Provider, certain risks or dangers may occur which could include:

- Physical, bodily or psychological injury or death.
- Physical exertion to which I am not accustomed.
- Failure of equipment or use of inadequate equipment.
- There may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport to treatment if I am injured.
- The conditions in which the activities are conducted may vary without warning.
- I may cause injury to other persons and/or other persons may cause injury to me.
- I may be injured or die due to the negligence, breach of contract or breach of statutory duty or guarantee of the provider.

I acknowledge that the activities are being undertaken for the purposes of recreation, enjoyment or leisure, and involve a significant degree of risk of physical harm. I acknowledge that the Activity may be undertaken with one or more other persons as part of a group and that the Provider is not liable for the actions of other participants in the group activity.

By signing below, I acknowledge, agree and understand that the risks associated with the Activities and/or recreational services have been explained to me. I undertake any such risk voluntarily and at my own risk.

I acknowledge that the risk warning above constitutes a “risk warning” in accordance with the *Civil Liability Act 2002* (NSW) and the *Civil Liability Act 2002* (WA).

Participant’s Warranties

I agree to abide by any of the Provider’s rules, and any direction or instruction given to me by the Provider during the course of the Activities. I agree to use and/or wear any equipment given to me by the Provider.

I declare that I am medically and physically fit and able to participate in the Activities. I acknowledge that I must, and agree that I will, disclose any pre-existing medical or other condition, injury or concern that may affect the risk that either I or any other person will suffer injury, loss or damage during the course of the Activities and notify the Provider of any injuries, illness or concerns that may arise during the Activity. I will not engage in any reckless, negligent or foolish behaviour or any other behaviour that is likely to cause injury to me, any other participant or person.

I agree that if I suffer any injury or illness, the Provider may provide evacuation, first aid and/or medical treatment at my expense and that my acceptance of these terms and conditions constitutes my consent to such evacuation, first aid and/or medical treatment.

I declare that I have not consumed any alcohol or mind altering substance, or medication that may impact my judgement or physical capacity, before or at the time of engaging in the Activities.

Exclusion of liability

I agree to and unconditionally release, waive, discharge and forever hold harmless, the Provider or any of its employees, agents, directors or officers, from any claims as a result of any personal injury sustained, whether caused by the Provider’s negligent act or wilful act or omission, breach of contract, breach of statutory duty, error, or otherwise in connection with or arising out of the Activities.

I agree that the Provider will not be liable for any claims for personal injury that may be brought against it as a result of or in connection with any act, omission, default, failure or error on the part of the Provider, and agree to indemnify and keep indemnified the Provider in respect of any such claims.

Waiver

It is possible for a supplier of recreational services to ask you to agree that the statutory guarantees under the *Australian Consumer Law* (which is schedule 2 to the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth)) do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights (or the rights of a person for whom or on whose behalf you are acquiring the services) to sue the Provider in relation to the Provider’s services or the activities that you undertake because the services or activities provided were not in accordance with the guarantees are excluded, restricted or modified as set out below.
