Conditions of entry

- In the event of extreme weather (40°C plus) the organizers will cancel the event and full refunds will be given
- Competitors must compete with the correct competitor number issued by the Society
- The Committee of the Swan View Agricultural society reserves the right to cancel, alter or combine any classes they may deem necessary on the day
- Competitors must wear an approved safety helmet in all rings and warm up areas
- Stallions are not permitted to compete in the hack rings
- Competitors may enter walk/trot or walk/trot/canter, not both
- Official Horse/ponies may only compete in Show Horse **or** Show Hunter, not both.
- A Novice horse/pony is considered to be any horse/pony that has not won 3 or more first places at any official fixture
- Official competitors must have original horse registration papers, height certificates, membership cards available on the day.
- All competitors under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult to be eligible to compete.
- Riders age is taken from the day of competition
- Disclaimer statements must be completed by Owner/Exhibitor <u>and</u> rider if the rider is not the owner/exhibitor
- All competitors must be a member of either EWA, or SHCWA for insurance purposes to compete/ride on the grounds **or** become day members of Swan View Ag Soc.
- The Swan View Agricultural Society committee and its' agents, representatives, promotors and organizers do not accept any liability due to accident, loss, damage to property, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other person whatsoever.
- The Judges' decision is final. Protests must be received within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the event, in writing with a \$50 fee to be refunded only if the protest is upheld.
