





#### ENTRY VIA www.vaws.com.au

- a. All exhibits must be registered with the WP&CS and the owner and/or lessee must be current members.
- b. Riders and handlers need **not** be current members of the WP&CS.
- c. All classes are run under the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of Australia Inc. Show Regulations as at Aug 1 2024.
- d. Non Member handlers and helpers (of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society) must sign the appropriate Liability Waiver Form and this must accompany entries.
- e. Welsh Members who have not included Liability Waiver on reverse of Membership must sign the Liability Wavier Form and this must accompany entries.
- f. All riders, handlers (including lead rein leaders and adults accompanying children) must be wearing a green wrist band.
- g. Ponies are to compete in either Welsh or Open classes.
- h. Open ponies are to be presented plaited.
- i. Part Welsh eligible to compete in Open classes.
- j. The program, timetable & judges subject to change if necessary. The organizing Committee reserves the right to add, delete or combine classes.
- k. NO dogs allowed on the grounds.
- I. Workouts are as per the WPCS website.
- m. Direct Deposit **WA RPG WPCS** BSB: 063 733 ACCOUNT: 1024 7246 and receipt must be noted entry form. All direct deposits **MUST** show in the WA RPG account by 6pm on August 9<sup>th</sup> 2024 or entry will not be accepted.

#### **WORKING HUNTER**

No change of saddlery is allowed between phases or during phases. Boots, bandages and protective pads on exhibits' legs or feet are permissible in the jumping phase only. Open to all Welsh and Part Welsh exhibits. Plaiting is not required. Both phases to be judged individually and consecutively by each judge. Any exhibit disqualified from Phase 1 does not proceed to Phase 2.

#### MARKING

Phase 1 Jumping to be judged on jumping style and manners

Jumping - 50 pts

Style and Manners - 10 pts

Penalties Phase 1 Knockdown - 10 pts

First Refusal - 15 pts Second Refusal - 20 pts Third Refusal - Disqualification

Fall of horse or rider either phase - Disqualification

Phase 2 Flat: To be judged on conformation, manners and freedom of action


