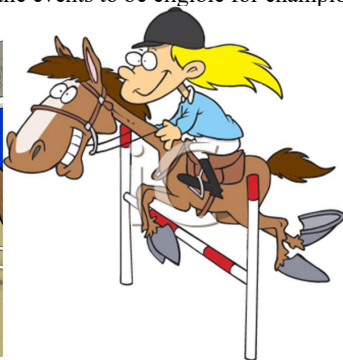


PEEL METROPOLITAN HORSE AND PONY CLUB

PONY CLUB CLASS/ OPEN CLASS

Dressage test followed by a round of 8 show jumps then out on to x country course for 10 -12 jumps finishing off going back into another jump arena with 2-4 more show jumps then through finish flags.- depending on height as to how many jumps.

Riders will be given a time for their dressage test and an approximate time for combination jumping course.

All riders must be a member of Pony Club WA either pony club or open member -Day insurance available for 18 years and over

Gear check will be as Pony Club WA Hickstead rules 2025 and National Gear checking rules 2025. You do need to have Bib number holder, Number either side on bridle or saddle blanket and level 3 safety vest to do the jumping and x country. Numbers to be worn in all phases.

Scoring will be as Pony Club WA 2025 Hickstead rules if any adjustments this will be posted on the board on the day.

- You may enter all 3 dates for the series on the entry form below, or just one at a time. On receipt of entry nomination fee is due. If entering all 3 the nomination for next date is due 2 weeks before said date.
- If you go up a height you will take up ½ points earned in the first event.
- If you go down a class in the 2nd event you can take all your points earned in first event with you.
- You can only go up or down a class for the 2nd one after that your points can not go up or down with you.
- Points awarded for series prizes will be:
 - 1st 8 points
 - 2nd 6 points
 - 3rd 5 points
 - 4th 4 points
 - 5th 3 points
 - 6th 2 point
 - 1 point for completion

1	A	Enter in medium walk	Rider sitting straight, looking forward, weight even into both stirrups. Pony straight, walking obediently		10	
2	X	Halt, Salute, proceed in medium walk	Rider salutes correctly, (reins in one hand, drops other hand down) Pony stands quietly, walks forward willingly		10	
3	C	Turn Left	Rider uses correct aids to turn. Correct posture maintained		10	
4	E	Working trot rising Circle left 20 metres	Rider squeezes pony forward into trot Keeps balance. Pony trots willingly, obediently forward.		10	
5	E A X C	Medium walk Turn down centre line Halt. Take both feet out of stirrups for 5 seconds. Put both feet back into stirrups. Proceed medium walk. Turn right	Dexterity in performing task without assistance from leader		10	
6	B	Working trot rising Circle right 20 Metres	Rider squeezes pony forward into trot. Keeps balance. Pony trots willingly, obediently forward		10

Collective marks

General Impression	Rider & Pony make a suitable combination. Rider relaxed, at ease. Pony obedient, willing to obey all transitions.	10	
Position of Seat	Good posture – shoulder, hip, heel in a line. Soft elbows. Looking forward at all times. Weight even into both stirrups.	10	
Leg Position	Long quiet leg, heels lowest point. Inside lower leg touching pony sides. Stirrup on ball of foot. Legs squeezing not kicking.	10	
Hand Position	Holding reins correctly. Quiet hands, not dependent on reins for balance. Hands are on either side of the pony's neck, one fist apart. Hands squeezing not pulling.	10	
Effectiveness of back, seat, leg and hand aids	Correct use of these aids will produce a forward, obedient pony.	10
