- All Exhibitors/owners must be members of **ASEA Inc or a recognised association to enter Ring 1.**
- Exhibitors/Owners must be a member of **IMHR Inc to compete in Ring 2**
- Day memberships are available for non ASEA Inc Members - \$10 per single & \$20 per family
- All Exhibitors entering the State Championship Ridden & Harness events **MUST BE** full financial members of ASEA Inc. Registrations however are open to all recognised associations.
- Making an entry for any event constitutes implicit acceptance of the Show Rules of ASEA.
- All competitors shall accept and be bound by these rules.
- Competitors are responsible for knowing and complying with these rules. It remains the full responsibility of the Exhibitor/Handler to comply with the rules as outlined.
- Breaches of these rules may entail consequences. These Rules must be read in conjunction with the ASEA Inc Constitution.
- Should any issue arise with regards to the interpretation of any Show Rule it shall be referred to the ASEA Inc Committee for determination. The ASEA Inc Committee will determine what interpretation is to be given and this decision will be binding and no appeal or protest will be permitted.

## ENTRY PROCEDURE

Entries must be emailed • Closing time for entries is **9pm Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2025**

- All sections of the entry forms **MUST BE** completed, including signing the show rules waiver.
- Copies of registration papers (front and back) **MUST BE** provided for each horse/pony not registered with ASEA Inc.
- All payments must be received by **9pm Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2025** (please provide receipt number)
- No refunds or credits will be given unless Doctor or Vet certificate is supplied (minus Admin Fees)

## ELIGIBILITY FOR SHOWING

- All horses must be registered with either ASEA Inc. or an approved ASEA recognised Equine Association/Society.
- For any ASEA Inc show, copies of registration papers must be provided with entry forms if registered with a society/association other than ASEA Inc.
- All entries must be made by the owner/lessee of the horses or ponies. The owner/lessee entering the horse must be a financial member of ASEA Inc. with which the exhibit is registered and proof of such is to be supplied with entries.
- To enter an ASEA Inc show, the owner/ lessee must use the complete name and registration number of the horse or pony as it is shown on the registration certificate.
- Pending registration for other societies will NOT be accepted.
- All entrants must familiarize themselves with our code of conduct prior to attending.
- All Exhibits must not exceed 12.2hh

## CODE OF ETHICS, CONDUCT AND BULLYING

Violations of this code may result in serious consequences under the Constitution. All, including Spectators, Competitors, and Committee Members, must adhere to conduct criteria below at ASEA events.

- Refrain from public disparagement.
- Respect all others.
- Avoid intimidating or degrading behaviour.
- Exhibit fairness, respect, and consideration.
- Never engage in any form of bullying.
- Avoid interference with others' property.
- Demonstrate integrity and responsibility.
- Prioritize horse welfare over competition.
- Maintain exemplary conduct on show grounds and in the ring.
- Must not influence Judges and appointed Judges Decisions
- Competitors must remain in class until winners have been sashed.
- Encourage genuine applause without compromising fair competition.

Adherence to this ethics code is crucial for breed and Association integrity. ASEA Inc. Membership signifies agreement to this code.

## PROTESTS

Competitors, Exhibitors, or any Show Official have the option to file a protest. The protest must be submitted within a timeframe of THIRTY (30) MINUTES after the conclusion of the class/incident. To validate the protest, a cash sum of \$50.00 must be submitted, with a refund available if the protest is deemed valid.

## **LEADING REIN EVENTS**

1. Leading Rein Pony - Horse or Pony 12.2hh and under, rider 3 yrs and under 8 yrs. The rider must not carry a cane. Spurs are not permitted

a) The pony must be suitable for a small beginner as this class caters for younger children starting to ride. Temperament and manners are paramount. A tiny child is not expected to be very much more than a passenger enjoying the ride, whilst the older child is expected to be a little more competent.

b) The pony should be willing, well mannered, obedient and relaxed. The Lead Rein Pony is expected to be a quality riding type pony with all the characteristics of a good riding animal. It should have an established and very settled head carriage with soft regular paces that inspire confidence in its young rider.

c) All Riders must wear a helmet to the Australian Safety Standard

d) Horses must be at least 3 years actual age

e) The pony must be shown in a snaffle bridle and bitted with a leather lead rein, held by the handler in the left hand, attached to the cavesson noseband. A narrow strap may be attached to the front of the small saddle for the child to hold if necessary.

f) Leading Rein Handler to be 16 yrs and over the handler may carry a cane not to exceed 40cms; the rider must have neither whip nor spurs. The handler should be able to hold the lead rein in the left hand about a metre from the pony with the right hand free to assist the child if necessary. The rider should be encouraged to rise at the trot.

g) Leading rein pony should possess a kind eye, good length of rein, be clean through the gullet and have a reasonably narrow wither so that the child can sit in comfort. It should have a good sloping shoulder, be short in the back and have correct hind legs.

h) The paces should be straight, true, rhythmical, and easy with a good length of stride at walk and trot. The action should be active but not so that the rider is bounced out of the saddle. In the class, the pony should walk at a medium pace and never over trot causing loss of balance. The head carriage should be correct in a rounded frame and still. The pony should halt without fuss and always stand quietly.

i) Manners must be impeccable. Must be quiet enough to carry a small child. Must only ever walk or trot and never run past handler.

**1. Presentation** - Manes and Tails. Manes are optional to be free flowing or plaited; tails can be free, plaited or pulled. False Tails are permitted

**2. Coat and Hooves** - Coat clean, with excess hair removed. Hooves oiled or blacked

**3. Saddlery** - Saddle (including girth and stirrups) and Saddlecloth Saddle should be of good quality and be supple and clean with sound stitching. Saddle should be small (14" or less)

a) Optional numnah or saddle pad.

b) Girth either white webbing or leather.

c) Safety stirrups (Peacock Irons, clogs & stirrup cages) are permitted.

d) Bridle (including bits and browbands) must be in a snaffle bridle (jointed or straight bar) Bridle should be the same colour as the saddle, supple, of good quality leather. Tasteful brow band to complement pony's head size, colour and outfits worn by rider and handler, e.g., matching hair ribbons etc.

**4. Judging** - To be judged on manners and obedience.

a) Workout should be a simple work out and show some transitions to show suitability as lead rein pony. Pony is led from back of cavesson with leather lead. Rider should be able to rise to the trot a little and assist with turning.

b) The handler must hold the lead in the left hand and carry a cane in the right hand.

c) The handler is not to control the pony unless the rider requires assistance the rider will be judged on their basic position in the saddle, hand, leg, feet in stirrups, seat and back position.

d) The class can be worked at a walk or trot both directions of the ring.

e) In the line-up, the judge may ask riders to back their horses.

f) If the judge asks the rider to back the horse in the line-up, the adult should not aid the rider.

\*\*\*For the safety of the horse and rider, the combined weight of the rider and saddlery should not be more than 20% of the horse's total weight\*\*\*

## **HARNESS AND DRIVING CLASSES**

As adopted by the Australian Carriage Driving Society Inc. plus those supplemented by ASEA Inc. as outlined in this guide. The rulebook of the Australian Carriage Driving Society Inc. may be obtained directly from the Society Website: [acds.org.au](http://acds.org.au)

### **1. GENERAL RULES**

- a) Horses must be sound.
- b) Correctly fitting breaching is compulsory in all classes except where "Tilbury" or "French" tugs are used.
- c) Vehicles fitted with open tugs must have breaching.
- d) An appropriate whip shall be carried at all times, the maximum length of which can reach the horses shoulder.
- e) Running martingales and over-checks are not permitted.
- f) ACDS accepted driving bits are compulsory for all classes.
- g) Blinkers are compulsory for all classes. Boot, wraps and earplugs are prohibited.
- h) Change of vehicle for classes in the same division is prohibited.
- i) No Horse (under 3 years actual age) can compete in harness
- j) All youth (under 18) are NOT permitted to participate in any harness classes with a stallion/colt

### **2. SAFETY RULES**

- a) All persons competing in driving competitions must have safety foremost in their minds
- b) A horse must never be left unattended while hitched to or being put into a vehicle.
- c) Competent adult co-drivers are recommended for all Youth classes.
- d) Passengers must enter the vehicle after the driver is seated with the reins in hand and passengers must dismount first.
- e) The arena layout shall have safe entry and exit gates and a collection area of appropriate width
- f) If the number of entries exceeds safety for the size of the arena, the class will be divided by the Show Organiser into sections from which the best horses per section will return for a final drive off.
- g) No horse is to be hitched to a cart and driven for its first time at a show.

### **3. RULES AND MANNERS**

- a) A ten (10) minute maximum warm up period must be offered in the ring before the commencement of judging.
- b) One adjustment of equipment by an attendant is allowed in the ring before judging commences.
- c) The Judge may excuse from competition any unsafe vehicle or equipment, or any unruly horse.
- d) Headers are optional in all classes excluding Youth where they are compulsory.
- e) Horses should enter the ring clockwise at a trot.
- f) After entering the ring drivers should take an inside track until all other competitors have entered.
- g) Driver must be on the rail ie. the outer side of the ring, as safely as possible.
- h) Drivers must drive at a safe distance behind the horse and vehicle in front.
- i) Driving between another competitor and the judge is deemed bad manners and should be avoided whenever possible.
- j) Passing is permitted by the inside or crossing the ring into space to ease congestion, but the driver must return to the rail immediately.
- k) A driver is permitted to talk quietly to their horse, but shouting and whistling is not permitted.
- l) At the completion of judging and on instruction BY the steward, the drivers should exit the ring in order of placing's after a circuit of the ring, in an orderly manner

1. **Acknowledge that a horse or pony may**, without warning or any apparent cause, buck, stumble, fall, rear, bite, kick, run, make unpredictable movements, spook, jump obstacles, step on a person's feet, push or shove a person, saddles or bridles may loosen or break – all of which may cause the rider and/or handler to fall or be jolted, resulting in serious injury or death.
2. **Acknowledge that horseback riding is an inherently dangerous activity** and involves risks that may cause serious injury and in some cases, death. Because of the unpredictable nature and irrational behaviour of horses, regardless of their training and past performance.
3. **Voluntarily assume the risk and danger of injury** or death inherent in the use of the horse, equipment and gear provided by me
4. **Release, discharge and promise not to sue** any ASEA State or National Committee Member, Show Organiser or Show Volunteer, doing business under its own name or any other name and/or any of its owners, officers, employees and agents (hereinafter the "Releasees"), for any loss, liability, damages, or cost whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury (including death) to my person or property.
5. **Release the Releasees** from any claim that such Releasees are or may be negligent in connection with my riding and/or handling experience or ability including but not limited to, training or selecting horses, maintenance, care, fit or adjustment of saddles or bridles, instruction, riding or handling/leading skills and supervising riders.
6. **Indemnify, and save and hold harmless** the owner, instructors, its employees and agents from and against any loss, liability, damage or cost they may incur arising out of or in any way connected with either my use of the horse and any equipment of gear provided therewith or any acts or omissions of wranglers or other employees or agents.
7. **The Undersigned expressly agrees that the foregoing release and waiver of liability, assumption of risk, and indemnity agreement is governed by the relevant State/Territory of Australia** and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by Australian State and Federal Law (**RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK**), and that in the event any portion of this Agreement is determined to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the balance of the Agreement shall not be affected or impaired in any way and shall continue in full legal force and effect.
8. **Acknowledge that this document is a contract** and agree that if a lawsuit is filed against ASEA Inc Show Organisers, National/State Committee Members, its agents and/or volunteers for any injury or damage in breach of this contract, the Undersigned will pay all attorney's fees and costs incurred by the fore mentioned in defending such an action.
9. **State that I am not now pregnant** and that I have no history of epileptic seizures, heart condition or any other medical problem that could be affected by horseback riding.
10. **IT IS REQUIRED THAT MY CHILD AND ALL RIDERS WEAR PROTECTIVE HELMET. IT IS MY UNDERSTANDING THAT A PROTECTIVE HELMET MUST BE WORN AND A CONDITION OF PARTICIPATING IN ANY AND ALL ASEA Inc RIDDEN CLASSES/SHOWS**
11. If the person who is to enter into this Agreement is less than eighteen (18) years of age, his/her parent or guardian must read this Agreement and sign below on the behalf of the minor.

I have read this entire Waiver Document. I understand it is a promise not to sue and to release all owners, volunteers and ASEA Representatives for all claims. I have made a free and deliberate choice to sign this Release and Waiver as a condition to ASEA Inc and its Representatives allowing me or my child to ride or handle a horse. I have concluded that the risks involved and the release and waiver of liability is worth the pleasure of horseback riding and handler experience.
