

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

It is a condition of entry that all competitors, whether engaged in any event or not, do so at their own risk and will indemnify and save harmless the organizing club, committee members and members from all claims, actions, suits or demands arising out of injury, personal or otherwise caused out of their presence at this show. Exhibitors will not be permitted to compete unless relevant Disclaimer Statement forms are completed correctly and any fees tendered.

The organizers of the show have the right to refuse entry to any person, or to demand the immediate departure of anyone considered to be behaving in an unsuitable manner. Exhibitors, Competitors and spectators are expected to read and adhere to the [SPPHAWA Show Rules & Policies](#).

THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ALTER THE PROGRAM WITHOUT PRIOR NOTICE

Led Presentation: All horses must be presented in a show bridle with reins or lead with the exception of Junior Fillies or Geldings under the age of 3, who may use a Show Halter. Regular Halters are not permitted. Plating is optional for Colts/Stallions, Juniors or any Sporthorse discipline that does not require plaiting of horses. Mares and geldings must have plaited/hog manes with tails plaited, shaved or pulled. Partbreds must be plaited or banded. Colts/Stallions over 2yrs of age must be bitted and handler carry a whip at all times. *No junior is permitted to ride, handle or be responsible for the care of a Colt/Stallion.* Whips are not to be used in handler classes and must not exceed 120cm.

Handler Presentation: Handlers must be dressed in suitable attire to run and handle a horse. No see-through or revealing clothing to be worn. Preferably suits, pants or skirt, shirt/blouse, a suitable dress or ridden attire with a hat and gloves. Fully covered shoes must be worn, jeans and joggers are not permitted.

Ridden Presentation: Horse presentation is that of Led horses with the exception that all horses must be plaited. Jacket, stock/tie, vest, breeches, boots, gloves should be clean and color coordinated to match horse. Helmets must comply with current guidelines. Junior riders are not permitted to use long boots in their rider classes. Whips must not exceed 75cm. Number holders are optional but preferred. Bitless bridles are not accepted.

HARNESS: (Rules according to Carriage Driving Society for Standardbreds)

Race Cart Classes - Horses must be presented in a race sulky only with plaited manes, tails left free and no quarter markers. The gear required is bridle fitted with standard block blinkers or Carriage driving blinkers, crupper, racing saddle (tie down or quick hitch acceptable) driving reins, breast plate. Dress code is the same as Led classes with the exception of skirts/dresses and definitely no racing colors or helmets. If a handler is required they too must be dressed suitably. **Junior drivers must wear an approved helmet, be assisted by a handler and they must also be suitably attired.**

Carriage Classes - Horses must be presented in a carriage only. General Carriage Driving rules apply.

RIDDEN:

Walk/Trot Ridden Horses - All Standardbreds are graded as Walk/Trot eligible until such time they have competed at SPPHAWA events for longer than 12 months and won 3 Champions. IF you have competed in ANY CANTER class at **any event** you are no longer eligible to compete. This includes eventing, dressage(excluding Prep 3) or jumping over 60cm. **Please read Page 7 of [SPPHAWA Show Rules & Policies](#) for further details on ridden gradings or contact SPPHAWA.**

Intermediate Ridden Classes - For horses that are further advanced than Walk/Trot but not yet graded as an Open Hack. These horses should show a degree of softness throughout the gaits and be capable of executing canter on either rein. Only SPPHAWA Intermediate classed horses or non- members confident their horse can demonstrate the requirements of this class and grade will be accepted. **Double bridles are not permitted in this grade with a snaffle taking preference.** Walk/Trot graded horses will not be eligible to drop back to that grade if they choose to compete in these classes. A judge has the right to ask an exhibit to leave the ring if deemed to be working in an unacceptable manner.

Open Ridden Classes - Only for horses that are assessed with SPPHAWA and graded as Open. These horses will have an acceptable level of training to walk, trot and canter in a rounded frame on a circle and also in an individual workout. They will also demonstrate clean transitions in all of their work and obedience to the rider.

Notes for entering classes:

Fashions on the Field – This class will be open to all Standardbreds, Thoroughbreds & Partbreds. Competitors may have a handler but they must have a waiver signed and day membership paid if not a member. Shoes must be enclosed and cover the top of the foot. Check FB event page for further details. - [2025 Standardbred State Championships](#) .

Best Presented Classes – all first & second placings of Best Presented classes are eligible to contest the Champion Best Presented Exhibit at the end of led judging. Including Partbreds.

Led Maiden – for any horse that has not won a **FIRST PLACE** at a SPPHAWA A class Event (State Championships, Dual-Code, Scorecard). Excluding Best Presented, Led Show Horse, Led Show Hunter, WA/Non WA Bred, Track To Hack or Handler classes. Also eligible to compete in all other sections.

Led Classes – you can only compete in one section. **Gender Classes or Sporthorse.** Mares/Fillies can only compete in one class from 12 – 15.

Sporthorse Class – this class is specifically for horses that compete in 'other' disciplines e.g Racing, Jumping, Eventing, Endurance, CDE. Proof of performance in the past 45 Days must be provided (results listing from such event. Lessons & Training Days are not eligible) with your entry forms. **You cannot enter any other Led Section – Stallion, Mare or Gelding.** Dressage and Show Horse competitions are not eligible in Sporthorse Criteria. See Page 5 for further clarification.)

Track To Hack – this class is for horses who have **raced or trialed** in their lifetime. Proof will be required with entry. A race history can be downloaded from the HRA Website – select Racing / Horse Search. You can search by racing name or brand or check your SPPHAWA Horse Registration.

WA Bred – this class is for horses that were bred in Western Australia.

Non WA Bred – this class is for horses that were not bred in Western Australia. If you are unsure this can also be viewed on the HRA Website or on your SPPHAWA Horse Registration.

Show Hack/Show Hunter classes – you can only compete in one section in the led and ridden, not both. Please select the class that best suits your horse. Descriptions on Hack & Show Hunter can be found in our [Track to Hack Show Guide](#).

Novice Walk/Trot – horses must not have won more than 3 first places at a SPPHAWA major event (State Championships, Dual-Code, Scorecard)

Intermediate Newcomer – for horses who are in their first 12 months of competing in the Intermediate grade.



Is Your Standardbred Unbranded?!

As of 1st September 2021, Standardbreds will be unbranded.
All competitors **must** register their unbranded horses with SPPHAWA. A lifetime registration is available here - www.spphawa.com.au/horseregistrations

In addition, all unbranded horses **must** be Microchip scanned on event day by an official and exhibitors to be carrying relevant documentation at all times.

Introducing our SPORT HORSE LED & RIDDEN CLASSES

Do you have a Standardbred that competes in disciplines other than Hacking or Dressage?

If you have competed at an event **within 45 days of our event**, this will make you eligible for the Sport Horse Led and Ridden classes.

The following conditions will apply for those combinations wishing to compete in the Walk/Trot Ridden;

Jumping – must not have competed over 60cm for all aspects of jumping

Eventing/Hickstead – must not have competed in Prelim tests or above

JUDGING CRITERIA

Style and originality of outfit with an understanding and interpretation of the current fashion trends including grooming, deportment and appropriateness of outfit for the Spring Racing Carnival and the individual.



Attention to detail with millinery, jewellery & other accessories to complement the overall look.
(Shoes must be enclosed with open toe, sling back or stiletto NOT permitted)

Turnout of the horse including appropriateness of the colour and style of the competitors outfit along with the colour of the horse and the horses accessories.

Handlers may be used but must be suitably dressed and have a Disclaimer signed along with a Day Membership paid if not an EA, PCAWA or SPPHAWA Member.

JUNIOR FASHIONS (6 – 15 YRS)

Annual Risk Warning and Waiver of Liability – Non Members Only

Description of Activities¹: Any equestrian event that is run by SPPHAWA

Risk Warning

I am aware that by my participation in any activities arranged by the Provider, certain risks or dangers may occur which could include:

- Physical, bodily or psychological injury or death.
- Physical exertion to which I am not accustomed.
- Failure of equipment or use of inadequate equipment.
- There may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport to treatment if I am injured.
- The conditions in which the activities are conducted may vary without warning.
- I may cause injury to other persons and/or other persons may cause injury to me.
- I may be injured or die due to the negligence, breach of contract or breach of statutory duty or guarantee of the provider.

I acknowledge that the activities are being undertaken for the purposes of recreation, enjoyment or leisure, and involve a significant degree of risk of physical harm. I acknowledge that the Activity may be undertaken with one or more other persons as part of a group and that the Provider is not liable for the actions of other participants in the group activity.

By signing below, I acknowledge, agree and understand that the risks associated with the Activities and/or recreational services have been explained to me. I undertake any such risk voluntarily and at my own risk.

I acknowledge that the risk warning above constitutes a “risk warning” in accordance with the *Civil Liability Act 2002* (NSW) and the *Civil Liability Act 2002* (WA).

Participant’s Warranties

I agree to abide by any of the Provider’s rules, and any direction or instruction given to me by the Provider during the course of the Activities. I agree to use and/or wear any equipment given to me by the Provider.

I declare that I am medically and physically fit and able to participate in the Activities. I acknowledge that I must, and agree that I will, disclose any pre-existing medical or other condition, injury or concern that may affect the risk that either I or any other person will suffer injury, loss or damage during the course of the Activities and notify the Provider of any injuries, illness or concerns that may arise during the Activity. I will not engage in any reckless, negligent or foolish behaviour or any other behaviour that is likely to cause injury to me, any other participant or person.

I agree that if I suffer any injury or illness, the Provider may provide evacuation, first aid and/or medical treatment at my expense and that my acceptance of these terms and conditions constitutes my consent to such evacuation, first aid and/or medical treatment.

I declare that I have not consumed any alcohol or mind altering substance, or medication that may impact my judgement or physical capacity, before or at the time of engaging in the Activities.

Exclusion of liability

I agree to and unconditionally release, waive, discharge and forever hold harmless, the Provider or any of its employees, agents, directors or officers, from any claims as a result of any personal injury sustained, whether caused by the Provider’s negligent act or wilful act or omission, breach of contract, breach of statutory duty, error, or otherwise in connection with or arising out of the Activities.

I agree that the Provider will not be liable for any claims for personal injury that may be brought against it as a result of or in connection with any act, omission, default, failure or error on the part of the Provider, and agree to indemnify and keep indemnified the Provider in respect of any such claims.

Waiver
