ACCEPTANCE OF THE RULES

All exhibitors lodging an entry into any United Breeds of WA Inc. (UBWA) event/s shall accept and be bound by these rules upon entering the event.

Competitors are responsible for knowing and complying with all rules and guidelines listed or referred to in this document. It remains the full responsibility of the owner/handler/rider to comply with the equipment rules and general rules as outlined.

Breach of the rules may entail elimination unless other penalties are stipulated.

ASSOCIATION LIABILITY

The United Breeds of WA Inc. (UBWA) or any of its Agents, shall not be liable for any financial loss or damage, physical injury or property damage suffered by any person or animal by reason of any defect, accident, natural disaster, negligence, or neglect however arising.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries to events are to be submitted via methods listed in the show schedule and must be accompanied by the correct payment and all supporting documents by close of entries.

Exhibitors must include the names of all persons attending the event as a handler and/or rider on their entry form.

By lodging an entry, the exhibitor shall be bound by the terms & conditions of the event. The signature on an entry form by an exhibitor shall be deemed to evidence acceptance of same.

REGISTRATION, OWNERSHIP, MEMBERSHIP & ELIGABILITY

The following rules apply to exhibitors entering classes.

All horses entered must be registered with United Breeds of WA Inc. Horses may not compete in breed classes they do not hold a registration for. With the exception of entries in the Show Horse/Hunter classes. Exhibits are to be entered in the name of the registered owner or lessee.

Non participation in an event will not warrant a refund of any monies. A strict NO REFUND policy applies.

Judges must not be approached under any circumstances by any competitor or spectator.

The judge's decision will be final.

There will be no substitution of horses/ponies from those specified on the entry form unless prior arrangements with the Show Co-Ordinator.

All handlers must be wearing covered footwear at all times.

The horses ages are calculated as at the 1st August each year.

SHOW COMMITTEE

The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse, cancel or accept conditionally, any entry at any time, without giving a reason for doing so.

MEMBERS RATES

Only current 2025/2026 members of the UBWA Inc., whose name appears on the Registration Certificate of an exhibit as the Owner or Lessee, are eligible to enter. Membership fees must be paid before or on the close of entries.

CONDUCT

Competitors and their team shall at all times behave in a proper and respectful manner to Judges, Show Officials and their fellow competitors.

Once Judging has commenced, the horse shall not be led or ridden in or out of the ring without the permission of the Judge. Competitors will refrain from smoking, drinking alcohol or taking any substance which impairs their ability to control the exhibit. The use of mobile phones whilst competing is prohibited.

STALLIONS

Exhibitors, handlers and riders of stallions will be required to abide by the rules set out in the EA Stallion Safe Practice Rules & Regulations Policy

Green stallion discs are to be displayed on both sides of any colt or stallion at all times whilst on the grounds and in all classes.

APPROVED SAFETY HELMET

Any person mounted on a horse is required to wear an approved safety helmet with the retaining harness secured and fastened at all times, in ANY class. Protective headgear must conform with current standards as per Equestrian Australia General Regulation
