CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **No Hay is permitted outside of horse floats or trucks – All manure and rubbish must be removed. Rubbish bags are available at the office. This is a Council Regulation.**
2. The grounds are public open space and cannot be sealed from public access. **All entrants must sign the disclaimer or they will NOT be allowed to compete. Riding on the grounds is not permitted if you are not entered.** Please report to the office to sign a disclaimer and pay ground fee (PH&PC members exempt)
3. All persons on horseback are required to wear a recognized standards approved helmet and boots as a condition of entry.
4. The committee of Perth Horse & Pony Club Inc. Reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any event/s they may deem necessary on the day
5. All competitors must be a member of either EWA, SHC, PCAWA or Perth Horse & Pony Club for insurance purposes to compete/ride on the grounds
6. Competitors and spectators shall at all times behave in a proper and respectful manner to Judges, Officials and fellow competitors. Any exhibitor whose conduct is considered to be ill-mannered, aggressive or unsportsmanlike may be issued a warning and subsequently dismissed from the class or disqualified from the Show.
BULLYING OF ANY DESCRIPTION WILL NOT BE TOLERATED
7. The Committee reserves the right to expel a horse from the grounds if, in their opinion, a horse's behavior is considered to be unruly or Intractable and/or which may pose a safety risk to itself, any other horse, or any person
8. It is always the responsibility of the rider/ competitor/ horse owner to ensure that the needs of their horse are being met appropriately and that the rules of the sport and EA Code of Conduct are being followed at all times. A Horse Welfare Officer will be in attendance. Any person found to be causing undue distress towards their horse/s will be dealt with accordingly.
9. The PH&PC reserve the right to interpret all rules & make a decision where any dispute arises.
10. The judge's decision is final. Protests must be received in writing within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the event in question, with a \$100 fee attached – refund will only take place if the protest is upheld.
11. Current Show Horse Council of WA or EWA height certificates must be emailed with nomination for the official rings. Height Certificates are not required for the encouragement & unofficial rings.
12. Pony or horse/rider combinations that have competed in the Official ring in the past 12 months, cannot compete in the Encourage or Unofficial ring
13. Horses/Ponies may only compete in Show Horse OR Show Hunter (Official Rings) (Not Applicable for this event)
14. Rider's age will be their current age on the day of event (proof of age may be requested for rider and child's classes).
15. All ponies can be ridden by any age unless otherwise stated
16. Competitors in the Encouragement ring are to compete in SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY, No martingales allowed and whips are to be a maximum length of 70cm. Leading Rein are to have a lead attached to the noseband. Organisers reserve the right to move a competitor if they believe a horse or pony is presented in the wrong class or ring.
17. All horses competing in show horse classes must wear a bridle WITH a noseband.
18. **Competitors competing in WALK/TROT that are seen to be cantering around the grounds will be asked to move to WALK/TROT/CANTER.**
(Unless competing in Preliminary Dressage WARM UP ONLY)
19. **Competitors competing in OTTWA classes must provide a copy of their OTTWA Passport and provide Horse ID Number with entry**
20. Stallions are NOT permitted in the hack rings. Tractable stallions may be ridden in dressage and jumping.
21. Under No circumstances is approaching the judge, judging or coaching from the side of the ring permitted. Failure to abide by these rules will lead to immediate disqualification and forfeit of entry fees.
22. Maximum of 2 dressage tests per rider & horse combination either same level or 1 level higher and riders must ride at the level either they or their horses' are eligible for. Horses and/or riders deemed to be competing at an unsuitable level by the organizing committee may not have their entries accepted.
23. In the event that two dressage tests are ridden at the same level, only the first test ridden will be counted towards any placings. Only 1 rider may ride a horse on any day.
24. Dressage rules as per EA Australia, but specific show rules or PH&PC related rules take precedence.
25. Plaiting and formal attire preferred for dressage. Boots, bandages and bell boots may be worn during warm up but must be removed before being gear checked and entering your test. Only on Matchy day shows may boots and bandages be worn during competition. These must be gear checked for safety before competing.
26. Dressage draw will be emailed to all competitors before the event.
27. All Dressage competitors must pay the helper fee, and provide a helper or self-help, to be refunded the helper fee.
28. Canteen will be available on the day.
29. Pre Entry Only – Refunds will only be given to competitors with a Vet or Doctors Certificate dated prior to or on the last day of competition. If you are genuinely unable to attend for an unforeseen circumstance and you have pre-entered, your entry fee may be held over until another event in 2025. Contact secretary for details.
30. The organizing committee of the Perth Horse and Pony Club Inc., judges, officials, DO NOT accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness or injury to horses, owners, riders, and spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. Entry to the grounds is at your own risk and the 'Waiver of Liability' form must be signed by all entrants prior to participation; this is a condition of our insurance.
31. **WORKING HUNTER**
This class is basically a hack class that combines a flat workout and jumping elements.
The horse and rider are judged on their ability to complete a set workout that includes 4 small jumps. This class is ridden individually and scored. The workout and judging criteria will be available prior to the day.
32. **Prizes for the best use of the tinsel theme in your or your horses attire. (Must be safe for you and your horse, and other horses from a visual perspective)**
33. **Classes may be split depending on numbers**
