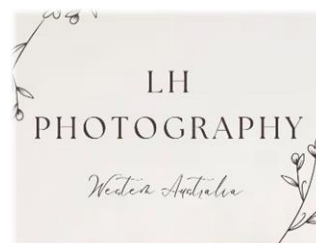

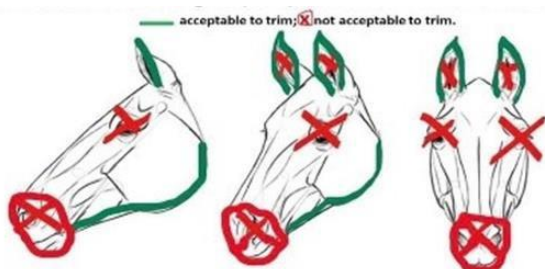

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – PLEASE READ PRIOR TO ENTERING

- 1. ASSOCIATION LIABILITY:** RWWA/SPPHAWA or any of its agents shall not be liable for any financial loss or damage, physical injury or property damage suffered by any person by reason of any defect, accident, negligence or neglect however arising.
- 2. AUTHORITY OF SHOW COMMITTEE:** The Committee reserves the right to cancel, alter or combine any event they may deem necessary. Any unruly animal will be requested to leave the ring or grounds. (Unruly being at the discretion of the Stewards and Judges).
- 3. CONDUCT:** Competitors shall at all times behave in a proper and respectful manner. Judges should not be approached prior, during or after the competition. Any exhibitor whose conduct is considered to be ill-mannered, aggressive or unsportsmanlike may be issued a warning and subsequently dismissed from the class or disqualified from the show. Exhibitors, Competitors and spectators are expected to read and adhere to the [SPPHAWA Show Rules & Policies](#).
- 4. ENTRIES:** Entry fees as set out on the Entry Form will apply. **REFUNDS of entry fees will not be paid unless the event is CANCELLED.** SPPHAWA Inc Committee reserves the right to refuse, cancel or accept conditionally any entry. Exhibitors will not be permitted to compete unless relevant Disclaimer Statement forms are completed correctly and any fees tendered.
- 5. OTTWA PASSPORTS:** Every Standardbred & Thoroughbred entry MUST PROVIDE a copy of the horses OTT ID PASSPORT or proof of application for the entry to be processed. www.offthetrackwa.com.au/off-the-track-wa-passport/
- 6. HORSE REGISTRATIONS:** All unbranded Standardbreds & Partbred Standardbreds must be registered with SPPHAWA (members@spphawa.com.au) & All Partbred Thoroughbreds must be registered with TPPSWA (tppswa@hotmail.com). Please provide copies of rego with your entry. For registrations please contact the relevant emails above.
- 7. PRESENTATION:** All Purebred Standardbred's or Thoroughbreds must be presented with plaited or hogged manes, braided or pulled/shaved tails with the exception of Colts/Stallions, Juniors, Race Conditioned or any Sporthorse discipline that does not require plaiting of horses. Suitable and substantial headgear is required on all horses in the led classes. Partbreds must be plaited or banded regardless of age. All ridden horses must be fully plaited with the exception of western disciplines who can be banded/hogged. All horses to be ridden in a suitable bridle, bitless bridles are not accepted. All persons on horseback are required to use a registered standard approved safety helmet. Whips must not exceed 120cm for Led & 75cm for Ridden. Please see [Track to Hack Show Guide](#) for all Presentation Guidelines.
- 8. SENSORY HAIRS: for Standardbreds only,** all sensory hairs must not be removed (whiskers and inner ears). Ears may be neatened but inner hair must not be removed. Thoroughbreds and Partbred Thoroughbreds, please follow the guidelines for your breed or EA\SHC rulings.
- 9. EXHIBIT NUMBERS:** Competitors may not enter any class without their correct exhibit number clearly displayed either on their back or in a number holder.
- 10. STALLION\COLTS:** may not be handled or ridden by any person under the age of 18 years. Stallions must be under control and always supervised. Stallions/Colts over 2yrs of age must be bitted at all times whilst being handled. **No junior is permitted to ride, handle or be responsible for the care of a Colt\Stallion.**
- 11. SPORSHORSE CLASS:** This class is specifically for horses that compete in 'other' disciplines e.g Jumping, Eventing, Endurance, CDE ect. Proof of performance in the past 45 Days must be provided (results listing from such event. Lessons & Training Days are not eligible) with entry forms. **If entering as a Sporthorse than you cannot enter any other Led Section (Junior, Race Conditioned, Stallion, Mare or Gelding) or Ridden (Newcomer, Show Hack or Show Hunter).** Dressage and Show Horse competitions are not eligible for Sporthorse Criteria. See Page 6 for further clarification.
- 12. LED SHOW HACK\SHOW HUNTER CLASSES:** Horses can only compete in one class, Show Hack **OR** Show Hunter. If you enter both classes you will not be refunded. Descriptions on Hack & Show Hunter can be found in our [Track to Hack Show Guide](#).
- 13. RIDDEN SHOW HACK\SHOW HUNTER\SPORSHORSE CLASSES:** Horses can only compete in one ridden class, Show Hack, Show Hunter **OR** Sporthorse. If you enter more than one of these classes you will not be refunded.
- 14. STANDARDBRED WALK/TROT ELIGIBILITY:** Any Standardbred that has competed in ANY canter classes is not eligible for the Walk/Trot classes in the Dual-Code program and also the Walk/Trot Classic. This includes competing in Dressage (excludes Prep 3) and jumping over 60cm. **Please read Page 7 of [SPPHAWA Show Rules & Policies](#) for further details on ridden gradings or contact SPPHAWA.**
- 15. ELIGIBILITY OF OTT & PARTBRED CLASSIC: TO ENTER THE OFF THE TRACK CLASSICS OR THE PARTBRED THOROUGHbred CLASSIC YOU MUST COMPETE IN AT LEAST ONE CLASS IN THE LED or RIDDEN SECTION OF THE DUAL-CODE PROGRAM.**
- 16. OTT CLASSIC & PARTBRED CLASSIC WORKOUTS:** Will be judged on Ridden components. Workouts will be provided once entry/payment has been received.
- 17. THOROUGHbred NEWCOMER HACK CLASSES:** Newcomer classes are for horses who are in their first 12 months of ridden competition. You must have not competed at any show prior to May 3th, 2025.
- 18. SWABBING:** Any exhibit may be randomly selected to be swabbed for prohibited substances throughout the event. Please ensure you have your horses registration cards on hand.
- 19. STATE EQUESTRIAN CENTRE:** All exhibitors, riders, handlers, grooms and persons attending events held at the SEC are to abide by the SEC's General Conditions Of Use – To View the SEC's Conditions - [Here](#).
