Ros Davis had an extensive love of horses from a very young age, attending equine shows as a child and later competing herself. Later in life, Ros met her husband-to-be, Phil, and together they shared a strong passion for horses.

Ros became involved with Peel Pony Club in 2002 when her daughter, Tamryn, was just seven years old. Soon after, Ros took on an active role within the club, organising Hack and Dressage shows. These events were extremely popular and were enjoyed by many members over a number of years.

When Hack shows were no longer held at Peel Metropolitan Horse & Pony Club, Ros continued her involvement and dedication to the equestrian community. She remained a valued contributor through running the canteen, organising raffles, and actively promoting a strong sense of community spirit within the club.

Conditions of Entry

1. PCWA Membership

Riders who are not current members of PCWA must complete and pay for Day Insurance via PCWA Just Go.

2. Right to Amend Events

The organisers and/or committee of Peel Metropolitan Horse & Pony Club reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any event if deemed necessary on the day.

If weather conditions do not permit the event to proceed as scheduled, it will be postponed and rescheduled for another date later in the year. No refunds will be issued until the new proposed date is released.

3. Liability Disclaimer

Peel Metropolitan Horse & Pony Club, its committee, judges and officials do not accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness or injury to horses, owners, riders, spectators, or any other person or property whatsoever.

Entry to the grounds is entirely at your own risk.

4. Plaiting

Plaiting is optional.

5. Rider Attire & Saddlery

PCA National Gear Rules will be referenced for this event.

All riders MUST wear Long Sleeved Shirt or Jacket. Matchy Matchy is encouraged. Riders are permitted to wear Club Uniform also if preferred.

Ponies and Horses will be permitted to wear Matchy Boots if they wish.

All riders must always wear a current PCA approved safety helmet and riding boots while mounted on a horse or pony.

6. Leading Rein Requirements

- Leading rein handlers must be 16 years of age or over
- Closed-in footwear must be worn
- Handlers are encouraged to wear an outfit that complements the rider
- Riders who need to be led/ leading rein riders, there are two options:
 1. If you are using a lead rope, it must be attached to a halter worn under the bridle. The bridle should not have a noseband.
 2. If you are using a butterfly lead it should be attached to both bit rings under the rider's reins. For leading rein classes, a butterfly lead or race clip should be used.
- When led, riders must still have their own reins.
- No leads with chains attached are permitted

7. Lead Line / First Ridden

Horses are permitted in the Lead Line / First Ridden ring.

8. Age of Rider

Rider age is determined as at the 1st January 2026. Proof of age may be requested.

9. Ponies

Riders aged 18 years and over are permitted to ride ponies.

10. Rider Rings

Riders are only permitted to compete in one ring except for Smartest on Parade and Rider Class riders being judged in separate rings.

Pony Ring will be used for riders 17 years and under and Horse Ring will be used for Riders 18 Years and older, this will only be for SOP and Rider Classes. Horses and Ponies will then move back to their own rings for Pony/Hack classes.

11. Rule Interpretation

Peel Metropolitan Horse & Pony Club reserves the right to interpret all rules and make a final decision in the event of any dispute.

12. Judge Interaction

Judges are not to be approached at any time. Any queries must be directed to the Club Rooms, where a Peel Metropolitan Horse & Pony Club committee member will assist.

Judges have the right to ask a rider to leave the ring should their Horse/Pony be deemed unsafe or unruly.

13. Ring Etiquette

All rings will commence at 8.30am, please be ready to start in time.

Riders will need to take responsibility to ensure they're ready to Marshall into the ring as per the program.

Rings class will not be held for rider who are not ready to ride.

14. Canteen

The canteen will be operated by members of the Peel Metropolitan Horse & Pony Club. Eftpos is available for all purchases.

15. Refunds

No refunds will be issued without a veterinary certificate or doctor's letter.

16. Entries

All entries must be submitted via the attached Nomination Form. Entries are not valid unless EFT Payment has been made.

All queries must be emailed directly to the organising committee via peelponyclub@gmail.com before the close of entry date.

17. Show Horse Eligibility

Horses or ponies holding a current Official Show Horse Card are not eligible to compete.

Riders who hold current membership with EWA or SHC may compete on a horse that does not hold an Official Card.

18. Manure Responsibility

All competitors are required to pick up their horse's manure in yards, at floats, and in the car park.

19. Yards

Day Yards are available, these are on a first come, first served basis.

If you choose to tie to your horse/pony to your float, please only tie to the back of your float as carparking space will be limited.

20. Dogs

No dogs are permitted on the grounds, if a dog is bought onto the grounds, then the associated Rider will be eliminated and asked to leave.

Approved Service Dogs are permitted with prior approval.
