4.00pm Sat 21 st March: Arena set-up the afternoon prior to the show – approx. 1hr	
7.00am Sun 22 nd March: Arena set-up morning of the show - approx. 30mins (erect 2 x marquees, tables, chairs & ribbon boxes in arenas)	
8.30-10.30am Sun: Gate stewarding and ring pencilling – require 4 people, 1 for each ring	
10.30-12noon Sun: Gate stewarding and ring pencilling – require 4 people, 1 for each ring	
Marshalling assistance for Supreme of Supreme awards (approx.. 1hr at the conclusion of judging of all breeds)	
Pack-down at the conclusion of the show , including dismantling arenas, removal of equipment, and general clean-up.
