CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - *please read carefully.*

This event is to be conducted under current EA Show Horse Rules and by-laws of Equestrian Australia (as amended) as well as these Conditions of Entry (together 'the rules')

Important Information – please read the Conditions of Entry – by entering the event the competitor will be accepting the Terms and Conditions of the event and is bound by 'the rules'.

- Horses and Ponies original current EA height certificate must be available on the day. No photo image will be accepted.
- Horses and Ponies must be EWA registered and hold a current EWA Show Horse Competition Licence which must be available on the day. No photo image will be accepted.
- Riders must be current EA members; membership cards must be available on the day. No photo image will be accepted.
- Horse/pony may only compete as a show horse or show hunter, not both.
- Riders must wear a current approved safety helmet and riding boots while mounted on any horse or pony at all times. Please refer to the EWA website for the new approved headwear. <http://www.equestrian.org.au/content/current-approved-safety-standards-helmets>
- Riders age will be as of the 1st of January 2026. Additionally, Riders turning 5 years are eligible to compete on the day that they turn 5 years old. See rule 5.5 & 5.6.2 of the National Show horse Rules.
- The Judge's decision is final. Judges are not to be approached under ANY circumstances.
- Protests must be made in writing and be referred to the ground jury, a deposit of \$150.00 must be made at the time of lodgment of the protest and this will not be refundable if the protest is not upheld.
- Horses and ponies must be ridden in Championship Classes by the rider who qualified them for the Championship.
- Lead Rein ponies are up to and including 12h. Handlers must be 18yrs and over and either Competitor or Participant members of EWA. See Rule 5.6 of the National Show Horse Rules.
- Lead Rein Riders are 5 years and under 8 years of age on the day of competition. This includes riders of Lead Rein Shetlands.
- Ponies that have competed as lead-rein ponies will be eligible to compete in open height classes.
- Owner/Rider - Horses must be owned and registered in the name of the rider or an immediate family member (mother, father, brother, sister, grandmother, grandfather). Leased horses are ineligible for this class.
- Ponies not exceeding 12 hands must be ridden by a child rider 14 years of age and under.
- Ponies over 12 hands can be ridden by a rider of any age unless otherwise specified on the program.
- Champion, 1st Runner up and 2nd Runner Up in each open height section.
- Winners of each class will be eligible to compete for Champion in that section. 1st Runner Up will be taken from the remaining winners plus the 2nd placegetter from the class that provided the Champion. 2nd Runner Up will be taken from the remaining horses/ponies in the Championship lineup.
- Riders in Child's classes MUST be aged between 5 years and under 18 years as of 1st of January 2026.

- Riders of Ridden Shetlands must be 14 years and under.
- BYO Alcohol is not permitted on the grounds.
- Dogs must be always on a leash.
- All prizes must be collected on the day or will be forfeited.



REFUND POLICY

Entry fees will not be refunded after the close of entries. In the event of a horse or rider being unfit to compete, a medical or vet certificate must be received by the office within 72 hours prior to the event and any refund will be at the discretion of the organising committee. There will be no further discussion after the decision has been made and given in writing. Certificates can be scanned and emailed to the EWA Show Horse Committee. Any refund approved will be less a \$25.00 administration fee.

- Random swabbing may take place in accordance with the EA National Medication Control Policy and the Equine Anti-Doping and Medical Control rules.
- Competitors may compete in all eligible events providing the relevant entry fee has been paid, if classes clash, due to the lengthy program, you must choose which class to enter, as the program will NOT be held up. NO REFUNDS will be given.
- The organising committee reserves the right to amend the number of classes available depending on number of entries and available time or move classes between rings.
- Camping anywhere on Riverside Riding Club Grounds is not permitted.
- Please ensure all manure and hay is cleaned up from around your float and taken away with you upon leaving.

RIDER FALL AND CLEARANCE

- Riders must be mounted on entering and leaving the arena on penalty of elimination.
- If during a workout, or on the circle there is a fall of horse and/or rider it will result in elimination from that class.
- If a horse leaves the workout area, other than at the direction of a judge or official, it will entail elimination from that class.
- The Judge has the power to eliminate a horse or rider if it is deemed by the judge to be erratic OR unruly.
- In the event of a fall by a horse or competitor, the competitor must report to the First Aid Officer for clearance. It will be at the decision of the Ground Jury (informed the First Aid Officer in the case of a rider or a vet in the case of a horse), as to whether the rider or horse can continue to compete at the event.

INDEMNITY

Competitors indemnify Equestrian WA, the Organising Committee and Riverside Riding Club against all claims, losses, suits and damages made against or suffered by the Committee by reason of any negligent act or omission on the part of any riders, trainers or attendants whilst they are attending, riding or otherwise handling a horse, and agree that any act or omission on the part of such riders or attendants found in any action against the Committee to be negligent, shall be deemed to have been negligent for the purpose of any claim under this indemnity. Neither Equestrian WA, nor the Organising Committee or their appointed officials accept any liability for any accident, theft or illness to horses, riders, grooms or to any person or property whatsoever.
