Conditions of Entry

1. **PCWA Membership**
Riders who are not current members of PCWA must complete and pay for Day Insurance via PCWA Just Go.
2. **Right to Amend Events**
The organisers and/or committee of Peel Metropolitan Horse & Pony Club reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any event if deemed necessary on the day. If weather conditions do not permit the event to proceed as scheduled, it will be postponed and rescheduled for another date later in the year. No refunds will be issued until the new proposed date is released.
3. **Liability Disclaimer**
Peel Metropolitan Horse & Pony Club, its committee, judges and officials do not accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness or injury to horses, owners, riders, spectators, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entry to the grounds is entirely at your own risk.
4. **Plaiting**
Plaiting is optional.
5. **Rider Attire & Saddlery**
PCA National Gear Rules will be referenced for this event. All riders MUST wear Long Sleeved Shirt or Jacket. Riders are permitted to wear Club Uniform also if preferred. All riders must always wear a current PCA approved safety helmet and riding boots while mounted on a horse or pony.
6. **Leading Rein Requirements**
 - Leading rein handlers must be 16 years of age or over
 - Closed-in footwear must be worn
 - Riders who need to be led/ leading rein riders, there are two options:
 1. If you are using a lead rope, it must be attached to a halter worn under the bridle. The bridle should not have a noseband.
 2. If you are using a butterfly lead it should be attached to both bit rings under the rider's reins. For leading rein classes, a butterfly lead or race clip should be used.
 - When led, riders must still have their own reins.
 - No leads with chains attached are permitted
7. **Age of Rider**
Rider age is determined as at the 1st January 2026. Proof of age may be requested.
8. **PCWA Insurance**
All riders MUST hold a Pony Club WA Annual Membership or if over 18 Years then Day Insurance is available via Just Go.
9. **Equine Vet**
There will be no Equine Vet on Duty, Vets will be available on call.
10. **Medical Team**
Medic Aid will be on duty at this event. All riders who dismount from their horse MUST present to the Medic Aid Ambulance for assessment.
The position of the Ambulance will be at the discretion of the of the Peel MH&PC Committee
11. **Canteen**
The canteen will be operated by members of the Peel Metropolitan Horse & Pony Club. Eftpos is available for all purchases.
12. **Refunds**
No refunds will be issued without a veterinary certificate or doctor's letter.
13. **Entries**
All entries must be submitted online via NOMINATE. Entries are not valid unless EFT Payment has been made. All queries must be emailed directly to the organising committee via peelponyclub@gmail.com before the close of entry date.
14. **Manure Responsibility**
All competitors are required to pick up their horse's manure in yards, at floats, and in the car park.
15. **Yards**
Day Yards are available, these are on a first come, first served basis. If you choose to tie to your horse/pony to your float, please only tie to the back of your float as carparking space will be limited.
16. **Dogs**
No dogs are permitted on the grounds, if a dog is brought onto the grounds, then the associated Rider will be eliminated and asked to leave.
Approved Service Dogs are permitted with prior approval.
17. **RULES**
This event will be run under the PCWA Rules and Guidelines. To be eligible for a Series Placing you must have completed 2 of the 3 events scheduled for 2026.
18. **Rule Interpretation & Event Decisions**
Peel Metropolitan Horse & Pony Club reserves the right to interpret all rules and make a final decision in the event of any dispute. The organising committee reserves the right to accept or reject a nomination without further explanation.
19. **Height Changes**
Should you wish to move up a height Class you will be permitted to carry your points forward with you to the next height. If you choose to move down a height you will forfeit your points. Height Changes are only permitted after the 1st Event completion. No class changes after the 2nd Event completion.

Scoring Points

Each of the 3 Phases will be scored individually, however all scores will be combined for Event Placings.

1st Place – 8 Points

2nd Place – 6 Points

3rd Place – 5 Points

4th Place – 4 Points

5th Place – 3 Points

6th Place - 2 Points

1 Point for Completion

*** 2 BONUS Points for completing all 3 Phases at one Event***

Minimum of 2 Events must be completed to be eligible for the Series placings.

Presentation of the Series Final Placings will occur after the completion of the 3rd event on 18th October 2026.

Single event entry is \$70.00 per event

Series event entry is \$195.00 (3 events nominated and paid for in full)

Lead Line Entry is \$60.00 per event / \$165.00 Series Nomination

General Impression	Rider & Pony make a suitable combination. Rider relaxed, at ease. Pony obedient, willing to obey all transitions.	10	
Position of Seat	Good posture – shoulder, hip, heel in a line. Soft elbows. Looking forward at all times. Weight even into both stirrups.	10	
Leg Position	Long quiet leg, heels lowest point. Inside lower leg touching pony sides. Stirrup on ball of foot. Legs squeezing not kicking.	10	
Hand Position	Holding reins correctly. Quiet hands, not dependent on reins for balance. Hands are on either side of the pony's neck, one fist apart. Hands squeezing not pulling.	10	
Effectiveness of back, seat, leg and hand aids	Correct use of these aids will produce a forward, obedient pony.	10
