HANDLERS

All handlers must be financial members of AMHS Inc. Change of handlers will not be permitted in the ring once a class has commenced without the permission of the steward. No exhibitor may leave the ring without permission unless instructed to do so by the steward.

EXHIBIT BACK NUMBERS

All exhibitors will be assigned with a handler or horse/pony number. The number/s shall be collected from the official's tent prior to the commencement of show. All exhibits must ensure that when entering the ring, the correct exhibit number coincides with the exhibit shown.

PLEASE RETURN ALL BACK NUMBERS AT THE END OF THE SHOW.

JUDGE'S DECISION AND PROTESTS

The judge's decision is final. Any protests must be made in writing, signed and presented to the committee within 30 Minutes of the judged class and accompanied by a fee of \$50, which will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program.

RIBBONS, AWARDS & PLACINGS

Ribbons to a minimum of 3rd place. Sashes will be presented to Champion/Reserve Champions. GARLANDS awarded to Supreme Winners along with additional prizes and awards.

TREATMENT OF EXHIBITS AND ANIMAL HEALTH

The Committee reserves the right to demand that any form of cruelty or neglect to an animal or unruly, diseased, injured or dangerous exhibit leave the grounds. No horse/pony to be left unattended at any time whilst on the grounds. Any cruelty will result in immediate removal from the event and further disciplinary action may be imposed by the committee of management.

GENERAL CONDUCT

Displays of bad sportsmanship and/or negativity via social media will NOT be tolerated. Exhibitors who disrespect other exhibitors, show management, committee members, judges or any such person may be at the committee's discretion asked to leave the grounds without refund of show entries and may be suspended from entering future AMHS Inc shows.

MARSHALLING

Exhibitors must be present and standing within the marshalling area at least 3 minutes before the completion of the previous class. Notification of upcoming classes will be announced for exhibitors to be on standby. All exhibitors must enter via the marshalling area and exit where instructed. Only horses/ponies listed in the events catalogue for a class will be permitted to enter the ring.

SHOW AGE OF EXHIBITS

All Halter Classes - Age is calculated as 1st August
All Performance Classes – Actual Age

REFUNDS

Your participation in a class will not warrant a refund of any monies. Entry monies may be refunded at the Committee's discretion if a Veterinary certificate and/or doctor's certificate accompany the request within 7 days from the show date

INSURANCE

AMHS Inc has its own insurance to cover financial members. AMHS Inc takes no responsibility for any injury, death, or loss to any person (competitor or spectator), livestock or property that may occur during this event. Competitors enter at their own risk. All exhibitors or guardians must complete the terms and conditions when entering online by agreeing to the relevant risk waivers as part of the entry process.

SHOW BREAKS

Exhibitors shall note that there will be breaks throughout the program at the judge's and committee's discretion.

Youth Ridden (Leadline) Classes (if offered)

The following Rules Apply:

This class is for youth exhibitors three (3) to nine (9) years of age as at the date of show.
The rider must show some basic

Open to horses & ponies registered with either AMHS Inc or a recognised breed society.

Riders must be led or accompanied by a competent handler aged 18 years and over

Stallions are not permitted in ridden classes.

AMHS Ridden Class Policy – Rider Eligibility and Horse/Pony Welfare

To protect the welfare of Horses & ponies participating in AMHS ridden and rider classes, the following rules apply:

- Size limits apply for ridden events to mitigate any welfare concerns relating to oversized riders
- Horses & Ponies must be a minimum 33" and over
- AMHS adopts and adheres to Equestrian Australia (EA) guidelines, which requires that **the combined weight of the rider and tack does not exceed 20% of the pony's body weight.**
- Riders must also be of appropriate height and build, ensuring the horse or pony's balance, movement, and welfare are not compromised.
- Horse/Pony must be a minimum of 4 years of age (actual age), must not exceed 12.2hh (50") and be in fit, sound condition to compete in ridden classes.
- AMHS officials reserve the right to assess rider-Horse/pony combinations at any time and may exclude combinations where over-mounting is evident or welfare is at risk.
- This policy applies to all AMHS sanctioned events where ridden classes are offered.
 - All riders must wear a helmet.
 - Horse/Pony must be bitted.
 - Horse/Pony may be plaited or free flowing
 - English or western attire is acceptable but must correspond with equipment
 - Equipment on the horse must correspond with exhibitor attire, including a saddle adjusted so that the riders feet are placed properly in stirrups.
 - Equipment must be of appropriate size for horse and rider.
 - A lead shank at least six feet long must be attached to the shank of the bit or to a halter that is under the bridle so that

while the rider is in the ring, the horse is able to be controlled by the adult.

RIDDEN CLASS PROCEDURE

The exhibitors will enter the ring with feet properly placed in stirrups at a flat-footed walk turning to the right and proceeding in a counter clockwise direction of the show ring. The class will be worked at a walk or trot both directions of the ring. In the lineup, the judge may ask riders to back their horses to help them judge the extent of the rider's abilities. If the judge asks the rider to back the horse in the lineup, the adult should not aid the rider. The adult should only keep the horse under control if and when required.

RIDDEN JUDGING CRITERIA

Rider & Horse Or Pony

To be judged on manners and obedience. The rider will be judged on their basic position in the saddle, hand, leg, feet in stirrups, seat and back position.

Coat And Hooves

Coat clean, with excess hair removed. Hooves oiled or blacked

Saddlery/Tack

Saddle (including girth and stirrups) and Saddlecloth Saddle should be of good quality and be supple and clean with sound stitching. Saddle should be small and appropriate to the size of the horse/pony
