Conditions of Entry

PCWA Membership: Riders MUST be current members of PCWA and an affiliated Pony Club or hold an Open PCWA membership.

Riders aged over 18 years who do not hold a current PC Open membership may apply for day membership through *JustGo*. It will be a requirement of entry that proof of current or day membership is attached.

Right to Amend Events

The organisers and/or committee of Peel Metropolitan Horse & Pony Club reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any event if deemed necessary on or before the day. If weather conditions do not permit the event to proceed as scheduled, it will be postponed and rescheduled for another date later in the year. No refunds will be issued until the new proposed date is released.

Codes of Conduct: Codes of conduct for athletes, spectators and volunteers as well as other relevant codes and policies relating to the conducting of an equestrian event under Pony Club and EA rules are available on the Pony Club and EA websites. At time of entry, you agree to the Codes of Conduct. Any behaviour considered not appropriate, the offender will be requested to leave the grounds. The organising committee have the right to refuse entries due to previous actions

Entries: entries and entry information will be available on Nominate only. Entries are not valid unless Payment has been made. All queries must be emailed directly to the organising committee via peelponyclub@gmail.com before the close of entry date.

Number of Horses per Rider: no rider may enter more than 2 horses in the event.

Helpers: all riders must provide a helper and select a preferred job upon entering. Duty preference is not guaranteed. **Self Help** – limited positions only if requested via contact with the co-ordinator peelponyclub@gmail.com

Withdrawals, Scratching's and Refunds: prior to the close of entries, entries will be refunded in full. Once entries have closed a refund will only be available if accompanied by a supporting medical or veterinary certificate within 7 days of the event. No applications for a refund will be accepted later than 48 hours from the completion of the event.

Rider Attire & Saddlery – Pony Club riders MUST wear their PC Uniform as it is a Leaderboard Event
PCA National Gear Rules will be referenced for this event. Open riders MUST wear Long Sleeved Shirt or Jacket. All riders must always wear a current PCA approved safety helmet and riding boots while mounted on a horse or pony.

Plaiting Plaiting is optional

Leading Rein Requirements

- Leading rein handlers must be 16 years of age or over
- Closed-in footwear must be worn
- Riders who need to be led/ leading rein riders, there are two options:
 1. If you are using a lead rope, it must be attached to a halter worn under the bridle. The bridle should not have a noseband.
 2. If you are using a butterfly lead it should be attached to both bit rings under the rider's reins, a butterfly lead or race clip should be used.
- When led, riders must still have their own reins.
- No leads with chains attached are permitted

Age of Rider Rider age is determined as of the 1st of January 2026. Proof of age may be requested.

Equine Vet There will be no Equine Vet on Duty, Vets will be available on call.

Medical Team

Medic Aid will be on duty at this event. All riders who have an unplanned dismount/fall from their horse MUST present to Medic Aid Ambulance for assessment.

The position of the Ambulance will be at the discretion of the of the Peel MH&PC Committee

Canteen

The canteen will be operated by members of the Peel Metropolitan Horse & Pony Club. Eftpos is available for all purchases. Gluten Free and vegetarian options are catered for.

Manure Responsibility

All competitors are required to pick up their horse's manure in yards, at floats, and in the car park.

Yards

Day Yards are available, these are on a first come, first served basis. If you choose to tie to your horse/pony to your float, please only tie to the back of your float as carparking space will be limited.

Dogs

No dogs are permitted on the grounds, if a dog is brought onto the grounds, then the associated Rider will be eliminated and asked to leave. Approved Service Dogs are permitted with prior approval.

RULES

This event will be run under the PCWA Rules and Guidelines. To be eligible for a Series Placing you must have completed the 2 events scheduled for 2026.
