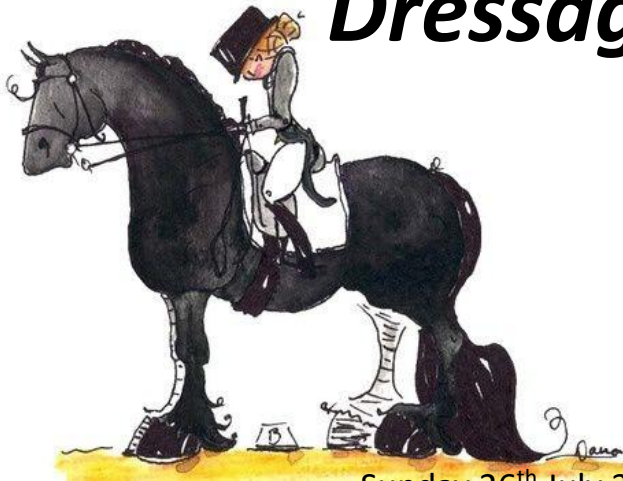

CONDITONS OF ENTRY

1. Only 2026 financial EA members and adult rider members are eligible to compete in this show - day insurance is available for uninsured riders
2. Club restricted classes – only 2026 financial adult riders members are eligible to compete in these classes. Riders may wear their adult rider uniforms.
3. Draws will be emailed to riders via the email address supplied and posted on the Facebook event page.
4. Maximum of two horses per rider and three CONSECUTIVE tests per horse and rider combination.
5. Ground fees and levies are mandatory.
6. PLAITING IS OPTIONAL
7. Copies of Dressage Tests are available on the Equestrian Australia Website and in our program
8. Rider's age will be as at the day of the event, proof of age may be requested.
9. This event will be held in accordance with the current EA Dressage Rules (as amended). It is the responsibility of riders to know what these rules are. All rules are freely accessible via the EA website.
10. Murray Adult Riders reserves the right to interpret all rules & make a decision where any dispute arises.
11. ALL horses will be required to wear an identification number whilst on the grounds, either by a number on the bridle or saddle cloth. Participant and adult rider horses will be issued a number via the draw. It is the riders responsibility to supply their own number and bridle or saddle cloth number holder.
12. Murray Adult Riders and its committee, judges and officials DO NOT accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness or injury to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. Entry to the grounds is at your own risk.
13. If you are not a direct member of Murray Adult Riders or an EWA member, you will need to fill in the DAY ENTRY FORM and pay \$10 competition membership, this need to be filled with your online entry.
14. **NO DOGS allowed on the grounds.**
15. No Judge is to be approached at anytime. If you have a query, please go to the Club rooms and seek out a MURRAY ADULT RIDERS committee member to help you with your query.
16. PLEASE PICK UP ALL YOUR HORSES MANURE, IN THE YARD, AT FLOAT AND IN CAR PARK
17. CAMPING WILL BE AVAILABLE UPON APPLICATION
18. There will be no refunds without a vet certificate or doctors letter
19. There will be no entries on the day. Please enter through the attached entry form
20. Every entry will need to complete a help duty which can be chosen via SIGN UP. If you do not choose a duty, your entry will be eliminated.

Whilst your test will be judged and placed, the main prize will be awarded to the best fancy dress!!

Riders who choose to do this will still have adequate time to unfancy and ready themselves for the remainder of their tests.

OFF THE TRACK: This class is for OTT thoroughbreds and standardbreds with a passport number. This class will be included within every test. Sashes will be awarded to 6th place as well as points which will be tallied and the rider with the most points at the end of the day will win the Best Performed OTT Trophy Rug in each ring. On your entry form, please indicate if you will be entering as an OTT competitor or as an open competitor – you may not enter as both.

ADULT RIDER CLASSES: This class is for 2026 Adult Rider members. This class will be included within every test. Rosettes will be awarded to 6th place, as well as points which will be tallied and the rider with the most points at the end of the day will win the Best Performed Adult Rider of the day. On your entry form, please indicate if you will be entering as an adult rider competitor or as an open competitor – you may not enter as both.

RING 3 – Protocol Ring

Tests: requested by rider

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR BOTH RINGS

- We reserve the right to change the location of the dressage rings for this event as we see fit. We will take into consideration weather, entries, ground conditions, etc.
- Horse and Rider combinations can only enter maximum **THREE TESTS**. If you are doing a Protocol Test, Competition tests must take priority if classes clash
- Classes will be broken into three age groups: Mini Dressage Divas (13 years and under), Dressage Divas (13 years – 25 years), Arena Queens (over 25). Rosettes awarded up to 6th place.
- Rosettes, ribbons and prizes can be collected from the club house after results have been announced.
- Every rider must nominate a helper. Helper jobs will be available via Sign Up. A link will be emailed to you once entries close and will also be available on our Facebook Event Page. Riders who do not nominate for a helper job will be eliminated.
- All riders wanting to enter the OTT classes must supply a completed OTT form.
- All entrants must comply with EA gear checking and standards. If the entry Marshalls notice anything about your gear OR attire being unsafe or not to standard, you will be asked to correct it before presenting to the judge.
- Adult Rider members may wear their club uniform.
- Thanks to the amazing sponsorship from RWWA Off The Track, if you are riding an OTT, you must choose if you will compete in the OTT class or open participant class – you can not compete in both.
- Thanks to Murray Adult Riders Club, we will be awarding a trophy rug to the Best Performed Adult Rider member. Please make sure you register as an Adult Rider entrant to be eligible. You must choose if you will compete in the Adult Rider class or open participant class – you cannot compete in both.

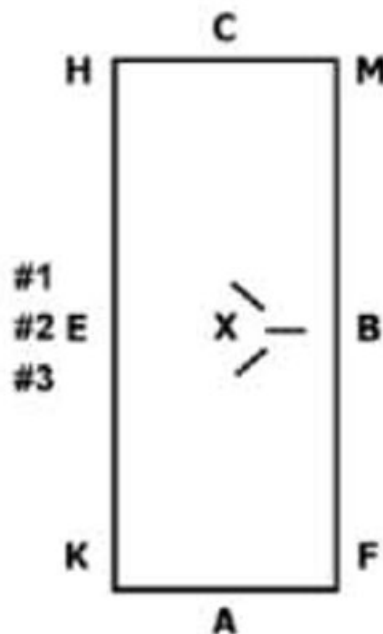

Prix Caprilli Test 2

Prix Caprilli Test #2 - For horses with jumping experience showing Training Level Dressage or above - maximum height of fences is 50cm. It is understood that in the working gaits, a jumping horse is not expected to be as round on the bit as a competing dressage horse. The horse must softly accept the bit and may show more "roundness" in the parts of the tests separate from the jumps. Trot work to be done posting. Transitions into and out of the halt may be through the walk. Test may be called. Refusals will be penalized as an error of course. Knockdowns will be penalized at the judge's discretion. In the case of a knocked down rail being in the way, the judge will ring the bell for the rider to stop without penalty. After the jump is replaced, the bell will be rung again telling the rider to continue from where she stopped.

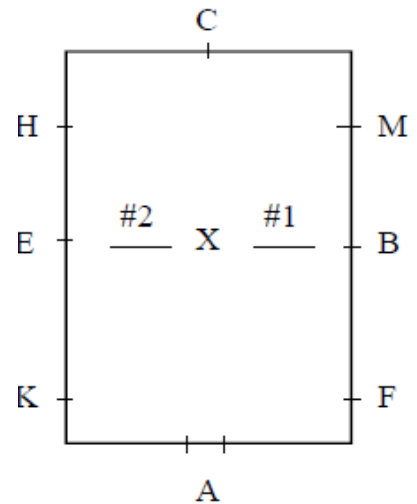

Prix Caprilli Test is for horses with jumping experience, ridden in snaffle bridle, competing at the Introductory Level and above.

Test will be performed in 20x60 meters dressage arena. Maximum height of fences 30cm cross rails. All trot work will be performed rising. The horse should be asked to change though the trot. The quality of the change will be evaluated. Test may be called. Refusals and knock-downs will be penalized as an error of course with appropriate deduction of points. Knock-downs will be penalized at the judge's discretion. In the case of a rail in the path, the judge will ring the bell for the rider to stop without penalty. After the jump is replaced, the bell will be rung again telling the rider to continue from where he stopped. Score will be calculated in percentage. Horses can wear jumping boots and riders can wear safety vests.
