All Nominations close Tuesday, 18th August 2026. Late entries for ring events will be accepted on the day for an extra fee of \$10. Payment can be made via direct debit to **BSB 633-000-Account No. 140 700 840**. When payment is made, please indicate your surname and whether you are competing in dressage **OR** breed events. I.e., Smith dressage OR Smith dressage/breed OR Smith breed. Refunds will be provided up to the 20st August 2026 with a medical or vet certificate (to be received within 7 days of the event) less 20% of the fee paid.

Riders to negotiate between events on the day. The program may be altered on the day.

Off the Track events – please supply passport details in the space provided on the entry form.

One rider per horse may get free entry to the show. All other vehicle occupants will be required to pay entry fees at the gate—*Off Lower John Street*. Parking in Cross Country Area ONLY

JUMPING

**Riders may choose 3 consecutive classes from classes 2 – 6
ie: Classes 2,3,4 or Classes 3,4,5**

1. 30-40cm Training round – Open to all riders (May be led). Start 8am – 9:30am. Only available BEFORE main jumping events --\$8 per round
2. 30cm Table C – Article 239 One round on time)
3. 40cm Table C – Article 239 One round on time
4. 60cm AM7 – Article 238.2.2—Immediate jump off if clear
5. 70cm AM7 Article 238.2.2 -- Immediate jump off if clear
6. 80cm Table C - Article 239 One round on time

The judge is only able to wait for 10 minutes at the conclusion of each class to enable latecomers.
