THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW!!!

The Toodyay Show is an ENCOURAGEMENT show and all classes are intended for everyone and anyone to enter, of all levels of riding ability everyone is most welcome.

You don't have to have flash gear! You don't need an expensive saddle or hacking jacket, as long as your saddle and bridle are safe and you are dressed neatly (you can wear your Pony Club or Adult Riders Club Uniform), you just need safe boots and you can ride in any of our classes.

We want everyone to be able to come to a show and have a go at classes and have a chance to win a ribbon or any of the fantastic prizes we have again this year!

ENTRY All horse floats must enter through **GATE 2**
the entrance to this gate is off Stirling Terrace, over the bridge on the left.

Gates open from 6am on show day

YOU MUST PARK as directed by the Parking Attendants
otherwise you may be asked to leave the show grounds

PLEASE REPORT TO THE HORSE TENT WHEN YOU ARRIVE

so that we know you are here & can check your class entries.

YARDS a limited number of yards are available on the show grounds, yards are **\$20 &** allocated on a first booked basis.

Classes if you are unsure about what classes to enter please come & see us, **we take entries on show day too** so you can change your classes or add extra classes if you want too

WE HAVE OVER **50 CHAMPION AWARDS** (& RESERVE CHAMPION AWARDS) & USUALLY THERE IS AT LEAST **3 SUPREME CHAMPION AWARDS**

At our show we try and make sure that **every Champion & Reserve Champion Winner receives a prize** as well as their Sash (and possibly a garland too). This means that **we need over 100 prizes** just to cover our champion awards and all of these prizes have to come from Sponsorships (as the Ag Society does not provide a budget for any prizes (they cover the cost of the ribbons). We also try and offer Judges Encouragement Awards, heaps of goodies for the little kids & carrots for all the horses & ponies as well!

ELIGIBILITY FOR LOCAL RIDER CLASSES

is anyone who is a member of the **Mortlock Pony Club** or the **Avon Valley Adult Riding Club** or who **lives in the Shire of Toodyay**. Remember depending on the number of entries judges may split or join classes at their discretion. Some of these classes will be judged all together on the ring and for some of the classes the judge may ask you to ride An individual pattern. Eg. Rider or Best Educated Classes often are judged by an individual ridden pattern)

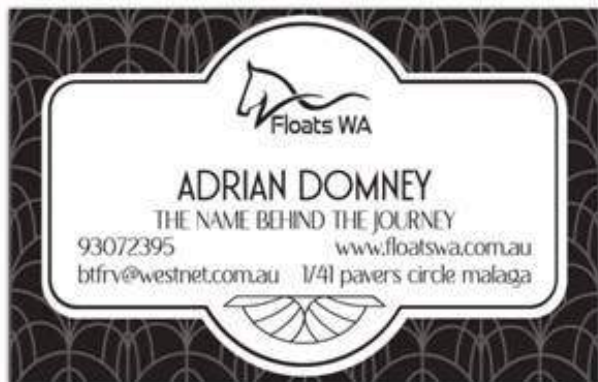

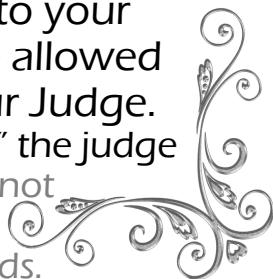

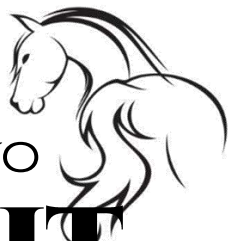

Points will be counted from **ALL class sections** on the program.

1st place counts for 3 points, 2nd place counts for 2 points & 3rd place counts for 1 point towards the High Point Awards.

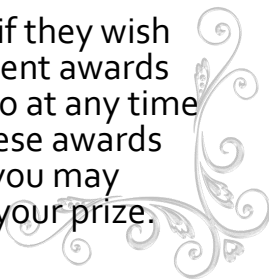

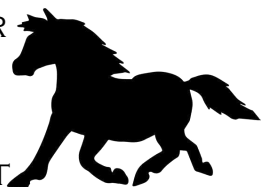

This will be announced over the PA & All rings will stop at approx 10:30am
to enable all eligible horses (anyone who has won Champion in their
Breed Class) to compete in the Supreme class. If your horse is eligible for
supreme and you are in your ridden classes you do not have to untack
your horse for the supreme run out unless you have time & wish to.

Once the Supreme Awards are finished
all rings will recommence their scheduled classes.

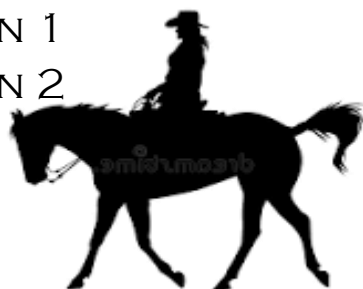

ENTRY All horse floats must enter through GATE 2

the entrance to this gate is off Stirling Terrace, over the bridge on the left.

One horse entry allows for 2 persons to enter the show grounds.

Any additional persons must pay the normal show entry rates at the gate.

YOU MUST PARK as directed by the Parking Attendants otherwise you may be asked to leave the show grounds

There is limited parking space at the Toodyay Show Grounds and every effort is made to try and fit everyone comfortably in. Any persons disobeying the Parking Attendants instructions will be asked to leave the Show Grounds and will NOT be issued any refunds.

If you wish to use float yards you MUST park next to the cricket pitch area.

YARDS a limited number of yards are available on the show grounds, yards are allocated on a first booked basis.

A yard cleaning bond of \$20 must be paid along with entry fees. Your name will be on your allocated yard. A refund of \$10 will be given if the yard is left clean and free from manure as checked by an Ag Society member when the exhibitor is leaving the grounds. Refunds must be collected on the show day.

MANURE Please ensure you pick up after your horse. Chaff bags will be provided around the horse parking area for picked up manure. Thankyou!

Unsure about classes? If you are unsure how a class is run or nervous about entering please be assured that you are most welcome to come and have a go at our show. We only have friendly, encouraging, wonderfully helpful judges at our show and you are allowed to approach the judge at the beginning of your class and let them know if you are nervous or unsure as to what to do and they will help you. Or come and see Tiff at the Horse Tent on show day and we make sure someone is available to help you.

EVERYONE IS WELCOME Taking your horse out to a show is supposed to be an enjoyable fun time for you and your horse (or educational) and we want everyone to feel welcome and comfortable to come and play with us at our crazy show! **JUST REMEMBER** everyone else is probably just as

nervous or busy as you are so make sure you are always aware of your surroundings whilst at the show, keep a safe space between your horse & other horses & people, remember to be courteous & polite to everyone including all our workers because everyone working at the show are volunteers & have had a hugely busy week preparing everything for the show & are probably already exhausted & a bit frazzled! **Most importantly remember to have fun & enjoy your day out with your horse!**

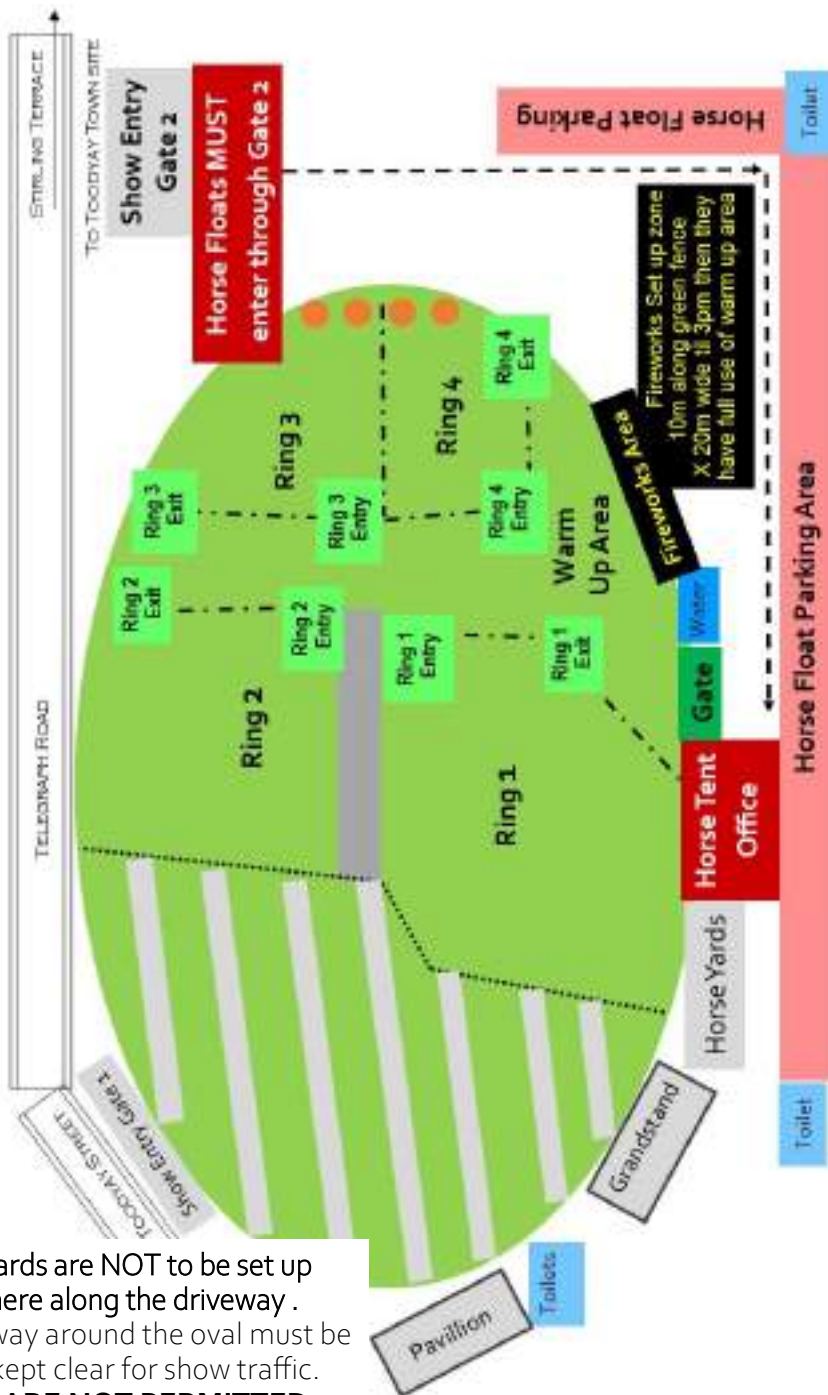
Then on show day you must come to the office and sign your entry forms and waiver which we will have printed ready for you.

All competitors under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by the Parent / Guardian as stated on the Minors Disclaimer Form.

ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES The Toodyay Ag Society reserves the right to refuse any exhibit entry without assigning a reason, if an exhibit entry is refused the exhibitor will be advised in writing (normally by email) and the Toodyay Ag Society's decision is final.

RULES & REGULATIONS

All competitors are expected to have read and understood the Rules & Regulations in conjunction with the Toodyay Agricultural Society Inc Regulations & By-laws.

CLASS & ENTRY RULES

LOCAL RIDER CLASSES A Local Rider is anyone living in the Shire of Toodyay or who is a member of Mortlock Pony Club or Avon Valley Adult Riders Club.

CLASSES MAY BE SPLIT OR JOINED depending on entry numbers and at the discretion of the Judge on the day. **TIMETABLE OF EVENTS & CLASSES**

CLASHING The Toodyay Ag Society have made every effort to include a variety of events and multiple classes for exhibitors to enter and the timetable has been worked out to try and avoid any class times clashing, however if this does occur the exhibitor must choose which class they will attend and which class they will miss. **CLASSES WILL NOT BE HELD UP TO WAIT FOR EXHIBITORS IN**

OTHER RINGS unless the Judge of that ring decides to do so if there is time to do so. The Judges decision to wait or close the class is FINAL. **NO REFUNDS**

will be given if you miss your class. **CANCELLATIONS** If any classes have to be cancelled you will be refunded the entry fee for the cancelled class only.

REFUNDS Entry fees will only be refunded (less a \$10 Admin Fee) only if a written request is received and is accompanied by a Vet Certificate or Doctors Certificate dated within 7 days prior to the show.

HORSES AGE The horses age is taken from the 1st August each year.

STALLIONS OR COLTS may only be ridden or handled by adults over the age of 18 years and must be handled in suitable head gear.

COMPETITORS CLOTHING All riders must wear approved safety helmets and smooth soled riding boots. You DO NOT HAVE TO HAVE EXPENSIVE TACK OR CLOTHING and you may wear your Pony Club or Adult Riders Club Uniform or any clothing as long as you are neatly presented for the judges.

COMPETITORS TACK All tack must be in a good and safe working condition and appropriate for the type of horse or pony. Judges reserve the right to ask anyone to leave the ring if they feel their tack is unsafe and that competitor will have to fix their tack and make it safe to the approval of the Judge in their ring otherwise they will not be permitted to participate in their classes and no refunds will be given.

By submitting your entry to this year's Toodyay Ag Show Equestrian Events you immediately and completely agree to the Conditions of Entry and all of the Rules & Regulations as stated on this program and the entry forms for this show.

RULES & REGULATIONS

CONDITIONS OF EXHIBITS & EXHIBITORS AT SHOW GROUNDS

ILL OR INJURED EXHIBITS Should the Toodyay Ag Society have any reason to suspect that an exhibit is ill or injured the Ring Mistress may insist that the exhibit is remove from the show grounds immediately. If an exhibit becomes injured whilst at the Toodyay Show Grounds it is a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Toodyay Ag Society blameless and indemnified against for any associated vet or treatment costs for the exhibit and/or any legal proceedings arising from any such accident or injury. By submitting an entry to the Equestrian Events the exhibit's owner/rider/handler is solely responsible for the safety and welfare of the exhibit. However if the Ring Mistress deems an exhibit to be ill or injured during the show day the owner of the exhibit will be informed that they are no longer able to compete in any classes and must remove the exhibit from the showgrounds immediately and seek appropriate treatment for the exhibit.

DANGEROUS EXHIBITS

Should any exhibit display any dangerous behaviour anywhere on the show grounds the Toodyay Ag Society / Ring Mistress may insist the exhibit and it's accompanying owner/handler are to be removed from the show grounds immediately.

INTOXICATED EXHIBITORS

Should any exhibitor display any intoxicated or drug affected behaviour they will be ordered to remove themselves from the show grounds immediately.

ACCIDENTS & INJURIES to any exhibitor, handler, attendee or exhibit.

The Toodyay Ag Society will not be held responsible for any accident that may be caused by any exhibitor and it is a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Toodyay Ag Society blameless and indemnified against any legal proceedings arising from any such accident or injury.

PROTESTS Judges are not to be approached by any exhibitor, all Judges decisions on the day are final. Any protest must be lodged within one hour of the class with a deposit of \$50 to the Ring Mistress at the Show Grounds before 5pm on Show Day. The deposit will be forfeited if the Toodyay Ag Society deem the protest to be unfounded or frivolous. Any prize money or prizes for the class in question may then be withheld in consequence of the protest and be forfeited to the Toodyay Ag Society (the next place getter does not automatically become entitled to the prize) and the Toodyay Ag Society shall decide the final resolution.

FRAUDULENT INFORMATION REGARDING EXHIBITS

Any exhibitor who provides an incorrect description, name, height, colour etc of their horse on their entry form in an attempt to exhibit a different horse than which is stated on the supplied copies of registration papers shall be disqualified from exhibiting at any future show and the particulars of the case shall be recorded in the proceedings of the Society and kept on record for future events.
